

From Cllr Steph McWilliam – October 2013

Thank you so much to those people who contacted me with their thoughts on the most appropriate rise in council tax. The responses were pretty closely split between those who don't want to see a rise (or only a modest one) and those who want to see services protected. It is difficult in the current climate. People on low incomes struggling to pay their bills are worried about any increases, whilst those depending on those services are worried that help won't be there. I will keep you posted on future developments.

I attended an event on Neighbourhood Development Plans at Bodmin, which was very well supported. There is certainly a lot of interest in this at the moment. There were two speakers from the Department for Communities and Local Government (DCLG) who answered many questions from the audience and cleared up a few points that had been causing concern.

At another meeting there was discussion about the management of the animals on the moor. Many people may still be unaware that there is a vet who monitors their welfare and acts when required. The message is still not to feed the animals please. It may be well meaning but it does more harm than good.

Finally, Cornwall Councillors are being asked to discuss with our parishes the need for an emergency plan. This doesn't need to involve a huge amount of work but, should there be a serious incident in your area, it can be a big help to have that local knowledge stored somewhere accessible. It isn't about trying to think about and plan for every possible type of disaster, which would be impossible. It is just to have a record of names and contact numbers of builders, electricians, plumbers, medical personnel, vets, possible emergency accommodation and other help that might be available locally. I will be talking to parish councils about this but, if you think you have skills that might be useful, please look out for requests for help and be ready to volunteer. Thank you.

This is becoming difficult for me to find the right words now and I am feeling rather emotional so must end while the paper is still dry. All my love to you Ruth

The Latest from Your Parish Councillor - Martin Corney

By the time this goes to press the window of opportunity to make representations to Cornwall Council about the Neighbourhood Area for the St Ive Parish Neighbourhood Development Plan will be closed – it ends 25th October. No other parish has had a single comment at this stage in the process, so I expect that we will be made an approved area this month. So now that that bit of bureaucracy is out of the way, we can get on with finding out what you want the future of the parish to be, and making it happen.

It's not straightforward looking at the future of the parish. Three hundred people in St Ive right on the A390, so good communications, but with few facilities. Then we have two thousand people in Pensilva, with the school, surgery and industrial estate, but at the end of narrow lanes. The trend shows an increasing number of retirees joining the community, while the lack of jobs for the young drives them away. This skews the population towards the elderly, with a surprisingly large number of single occupancy dwellings. I'm working on the Community Profile document which shows the current state of the parish, which is why I see these issues which our Neighbourhood Plan will need to address.

The Neighbourhood Development Plan Working Group has now been given Terms of Reference by the Parish Council, which at least gives us all an idea of what we are supposed to be doing. We will be looking to include "local members of the community who can bring value to the project" in the working group, so keep a look out for forthcoming events.

The Facebook Page "St Ive Parish Council" (which non-Facebook users can view at www.facebook.com/stiveparishcouncil) is being updated regularly with local news items. Tell me if you want different items, or join in and be an editor/contributor. Maybe your group wants some internet visibility for your events – just ask.

The parish web site is still very much a "work in progress". I'm still looking for contributions – background information about the parish would be good. Also, if you want to learn and join in creating the web site, I'm still looking for volunteers.





PENSILVA HISTORY GROUP

The History Group held their monthly meeting on Wednesday evening 25th September at 7.30pm in Millennium House. Since this was the Group's first meeting since June, the chairman took the opportunity to catch up with business and happenings through the summer.

The visit to St Ive Church in June was very interesting. The Group were made very welcome and given an informative tour followed by a very hospitable tea and biscuits. The chairman read out a letter of thanks from Mr Ken Wilcock for a small donation the Group had made to the church funds. In July the Group had organised a walk around South Caradon Mine and the Gonamena valley. The walk was led by Mr John Manley who is a member of the Trevithick Society and an expert on the local mines. The walk was well attended and the evening mist that came down heightened the moorland atmosphere.

The Group had received several enquiries on their website (www.pensilvahistorygroup.org) over the summer and had answered them as best they could. One enquiry regarding a hanging in Goodman's Lane brought to light a sad tale of a suicide there in the 1930s that none of the Group were previously aware of. The chairman has also been in contact with a Mr Paul Tregilgas in New Zealand. Paul's ancestors are from Pensilva and the surrounding area.






