

## **The Latest from Your Parish Councillor - Martin Corney**

With different responsible adults, I've started opening the Millennium House Cafe each Thursday evening between 6.30pm and 8.30pm so that the youths of Pensilva have somewhere warm and safe to gather for the evening, instead of being out in the cold. One of the girls asked me "Do you get paid for this", (I don't, I volunteer), but this got me thinking. I heard the Rev. Richard Coles on the radio talking about how worried he was for communities in this secular age. How the decline of the church, which used to be the "organised goodness" that brought everyone together, wasn't adequately replaced by the welfare state. As one of the secular members of the community, volunteering on the Parish Council, Pensilva Youth Projects, and even Callington Food Bank is my way of putting something back and bringing us together. It also keeps me busy instead of being slumped in front of the TV now I'm retired.

Here's an idea for bringing the community together that sounded interesting, "The Big Lunch" is something started by Tim Smit of the Eden Project. The idea is that, throughout the country, street parties happen on the same day, with neighbours sharing food and ideas, meeting neighbours they may never have spoken to before. This year it's Sunday 1st June. Anybody interested?

It was surprising to hear that Shaun Ellis and his wife Kim are moving their wolves to the parish. You might have seen Shaun on the TV actually living with his wolves as a pack member. They failed to get planning permission in North Devon, so are moving here. Their new neighbours are concerned about the effect that a pack of howling wolves will have on their sheep and horses. Can livestock learn to become accustomed to the noise? I don't know. Will a Wolf Centre be a tourist attraction creating local jobs? I've asked them to give a presentation about the move, so hopefully we'll get to ask questions and get answers.

## **From Cllr Steph McWilliam – February 2014**

What can I say about the weather? I do hope that by the time you read this it has improved and we are finally starting to dry out but it is certainly the worst I can remember. Of course, we are better off than some but it is surely taking its toll. Do please keep an eye out for neighbours who may need help or just a quick visit to check they are coping alright.

One effect, of course, is on our roads. You don't need me to tell you that the constant running water is damaging the surface all over the place. All I can say is that our council staff are out in these conditions doing their very best. In the meantime, we need to take extra care because these potholes are almost impossible to see when they are full of water, particularly in the dark. Please also take care on the moor. Animals are still dying because they are being hit by vehicles and all too often it is locals who are causing these collisions.

On a brighter note, my community chest is empty. I am delighted that all the money is going to local organisations and split pretty evenly across the three parishes I represent. Thank you to those people working hard for their communities in so many ways and I am delighted to have been able to provide a little extra support. Discussion is underway about the possibility of Bodmin Moor applying for 'Dark Skies Designation'. We are very fortunate to have the open space and air purity that makes this a great place to view the night sky but light pollution could spoil it. It wouldn't mean that there couldn't be any development but might require conditions to impose control of lighting so that it didn't travel upwards. Dark skies are considered good for tourism and there is significant interest in astronomy and space exploration so it could be very good for our young people's education as well. Do let me know what you think.

Finally, I have been hearing about some communities where local volunteers have taken on the role of local dog wardens. Training is available and they would be supported by the Cornwall Council Dog Warden. However, one person covers this service from Torpoint to Launceston and to the edge of Looe so he can't get out to every village very often. If you might be interested, please let your Parish Clerk know in the first instance.

**GROWING.** Despite the ghastly wind and rain, we have all sorts of things growing in the tunnel. Kales, caulis, cabbage and broccoli are coming up in seed trays for planting out later. Lettuce, beetroot, chard, onions, garlic and 1<sup>st</sup> early potatoes are coming up and broad beans are in flower: it looks like a good crop.

**LORRY NEEDED.** We have been offered 2 large loads of much-needed manure and need a 5-ton tipper truck or trailer to get it here. We are happy to pay to have it for the next dry day. Please let us know if you can help.

**VEG BOX SCHEME.** We are continuing to gain new customers: this is fantastic and really helps us continue our work. **Box prices** £7.50 for 1 /2 people, £10 for 3/ 4 people and £5 fruit bag. If you prefer us to deliver to your own shopping list, just let us know and we'll send you a pricelist. In common with many box schemes and because we have such a small growing area here, we are buying in quite a lot of produce to ensure our customers receive a good range of vegetables and fruit. The good news is that we have great links with other Cornish organic growers delivering high quality, fresh, local grown food. Keveral Organic Growers are from nr Seaton and Trevalon Organic Vegetables are nr Herodsfoot. Best of all, we have agreed our next 6 months supply from Tregillis Organic Farm at South Petherwin and our volunteers have had a great time helping prepare their triple-span tunnel for planting. Boy, did we get muddy!!

**VOLUNTEERING** Having more new volunteers has really given us a boost. With clearer weather, we will be really able to crack on and prepare for spring planting. Meanwhile, we are busy sowing seed and transplanting seedlings.

We meet every Wednesday 10 a.m. – 2pm. Lunch provided

**POLYTUNNEL APPEAL** Delightfully, we have raised **£867.50** towards a new poly-tunnel. Steph McWilliam arranged a grant of £500 from her community fund, we had a donation of £200 from Helen Wilson, Mrs Cotterill donated £50, Lesley Welch £40 and lots of others gave £10 each. If you are able to make a donation we would be so grateful: **we need to raise £1,000** as quickly as possible, so we can get the tunnel up and planted out by Spring, when peak production starts.

### **VILLAGE HISTORY GROUP**


The Village History Group held their third Annual General Meeting in Millennium House on Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> January 2014 at 7.30pm.

The Chairman opened the Meeting by welcoming the members. He stated that the Group had experienced another interesting year. They had exhibited at Liskeard Show during last summer and also at Pensilva Gala Day and a CHAHP sponsored event at Upton Cross in October. The Group had received a conducted tour of St Ive church in May and had organised a walk, led by John Manley of the Trevithick Society to South Caradon Mine and Gonamena in July. Also during the course of the year the Chairman had given an illustrated talk entitled 'A Brief History of Pensilva' to St Ive Church members, Liskeard and Looe Rotary Club, Linkinhorne History Group and at Millennium House in Pensilva itself in October.

The Group were represented at the CHAHP Castle Hill Project in Liskeard in the summer and the members had all visited the excavation project at The Hurlers. The Caradon Hill Area Heritage Project which has sponsored all the local groups for the past three years has now finished but a legacy group has formed which will hopefully take over from where CHAHP left off.

The Chairman thanked Alistair Taylor who has done a lot of work on recording the local census details for Pensilva and St Ive from 1841 onwards. This work has provided a most interesting exhibit whenever it has been displayed. 

## HELP!

The Friends of Pensilva Health Centre will have a vacancy for the voluntary role of Treasurer from May 2013.

The Friends exist to raise and manage funds for the Health Centre. The funds are used to purchase items of equipment that are of benefit to the patients but which are not routinely supplied to GP practices. Over the twenty plus years of our existence many items, from an ECG machine to portable 24 hour blood pressure monitors, have been funded meaning that often patients do not have to wait for a hospital appointment and then make the journey to either Liskeard or Plymouth, but can be treated at the Health Centre. The most recent purchase was a Dopplex machine, which cost over £3,000; it is in daily use detecting potentially life threatening vascular problems.

The role of Treasurer is not greatly time consuming. The Friends have three meetings a year and two fund raising events. In addition there are occasional donations from patients and patients' families and friends. The current Treasurer has offered to answer any questions that may arise from the handover.
