The Latest from Your Parish Councillor - Martin Corney

In my contributions to the Parish Pump I always try to keep you informed about what is going on in the parish in an impartial and objective way. So I was disappointed to be personally criticised for my reporting of what I have written about Sean Ellis moving his Wolf Centre to the parish. For those of you who do not have access to the internet and were not at the meeting...

At very short notice the Parish Council invited Shaun Ellis to an informal question and answer session so the community could find out what is going on. I was very pleased that, even in just a few days, word-of-mouth and the internet attracted so many people that it was standing room only.

On the internet I reported "There seemed to be about the same number of people who welcomed the Wolf Centre as were hostile. Shaun Ellis said that the Wolf Centre has 7 mature wolves, all raised in captivity. The wolf enclosure will be kept about 40m from the road and buildings are being soundproofed. The noise should be less annoying than the nearby dog kennels. Livestock and horses will not be disturbed. His daughter rides her horse by the wolves OK. They will have a small number of visitors (about 6 at a time) who will stay in local B&B. They have never had a wolf escape and they advise internationally as containment is their speciality. - Neighbours were concerned about the noise and risk of wolves, also a previous mobile home on the site burned out as the fire brigade did not have adequate water pressure when they attended." My personal opinion is that wild animals should be free in the wild, but if Shaun Ellis keeps to the rules he is welcome as a member of the community. The next big thing happening in the parish, is trying to run Millennium House through an organisation at arm's length from the parish council. I think this is a good idea and that both the parish and Millennium House will be run better. Don't forget the parish website st-ive-parishcouncil.gov.uk with council meeting agendas and minutes; also downloadable copies of the Parish Pump. For those of you who do Facebook, our St Ive Parish Council page is still being updated with parish news.


From Cllr Steph McWilliam - March 2014

At last, the sun is shining and signs of Spring are all around us. This weather really does make me appreciate living in such a beautiful part of the world.

The main issues at County Hall are currently the implications of the national welfare reforms and what our priorities should be in the next few years as we have to make further cuts in expenditure. At the moment I am working my way through the services I feel must be protected and those which I feel we could live without if we must. There are ways in which we could work with the voluntary sector to ensure things can continue in a different way but costing council tax payers less. The mobile library service is one example where the RVS is offering to provide a delivery direct to some people's homes. This could arguably be a better service for some people. I wish to see services for children and vulnerable adults protected but think we could look at some services differently. One example of this might be seeking local volunteers to be trained as dog wardens.

I am still receiving many enquiries about when the potholes are going to be fixed. It seems to me that spending on highways has been cut too much and we are all finding it difficult to get around as a result, so this is an area where I would be pushing for expenditure to be increased. To help fund this, I would be happy to see savings in the 'green Cornwall' projects. I am all in favour of looking after the environment but I do feel that some of our efforts are futile until the large industrial economies take some action to reduce their emissions. I would also vote against any of your council tax being spent on the Cornish Language programme.....unless you tell me differently!

I was pleased to chair the public meeting about the possibility of wolves coming to the parish. There are strong views on both sides of the debate but it is a credit to our community that we can hold these sorts of meetings and allow everyone to speak and be heard in a respectful way. At the time of writing, Shaun and Kim are still seeking the necessary permissions and licences so no decision has been made. Do let me know your thoughts on any of the above. I am here to represent you but I can only do that if you let me know how you feel. Thank you.

GROWING We've had the outside growing area under heavy plastic since January to suppress weeds; it also minimised waterlogging. The lovely Paddy Long and Tony Vincent have just ploughed and rotivated it for us, ready for planting. Given that this time 4 years ago, this was a weedy, rocky nightmare, I am so proud of the lovely soil that's emerged; we've done a great job of improving its depth and fertility: that was a lot of hard labour and muck shovelling by our wonderful volunteers.

We have been busy making new beds where old greenhouses were and have replanted the strawberries into fresh soil, hoping for another bumper crop this year.

This month we've planted out parsnips, onions, garlic and cauliflowers: soon we'll plant broad beans and pea seed. Like everyone else, we need slightly warmer soil before we can get the spuds in, but are hopeful that will happen before months end.

COMMUNITY COMPOST SCHEME As many of you know, we are very happy to accept your lawn clippings, used rabbit bedding, cuttings, etc etc. at our compost bins by the gate. The only thing we need to be careful of is that **none of it has been sprayed with weed-killer.** If you use weed-killer on your lawn, please dispose of your clippings through the Council scheme, as it could damage our crops.

URGENT - LORRY NEEDED We have been offered 2 large loads of much-needed manure and need a 5-ton tipper truck or trailer to get it here. We are happy to pay to have it for the next dry day. Please let us know if you can help.

VEG BOX SCHEME We are continuing to gain new customers: this is fantastic and really helps us continue our work.

Now they collect for charity. Moa sang of the Great Blizzard in the 1800s when the snow was as high as the hedges. She recalled how all the villages had a shop which sold everything! A great focal point for the village. At Easter everyone had a new item of clothing to go to church, even if it was only a new ribbon. May Day in Padstow was 'Obby Orse Day' and on the last stroke of midnight they'd go around the houses singing until the early hours and then join the parade through Padstow. Finally Xmas when she ended her talk with a recitation and a carol. It was a very interesting and unusual talk from Moa and her husband who accompanied her with her songs.

The Friends of Pensilva Health Centre will have a vacancy for the voluntary role of Secretary from May 2014.

The Friends exist to raise and manage funds for the Health Centre. The funds are used to purchase items of equipment that are of benefit to the patients but which are not routinely supplied to GP practices. Over the twenty plus years of our existence many items, from an ECG machine to portable 24 hour blood pressure monitors, have been funded meaning that often patients do not have to wait for a hospital appointment and then make the journey to either Liskeard or Plymouth, but can be treated at the Health Centre. Recently, the purchase of an additional portable 24-hour ECG machine was agreed. This will be a more advanced machine able to detect and record incidents of which the patient is unaware.

The Friends have three meetings a year and two fund raising events. The role of Secretary involves taking Minutes of the meetings, occasional letter writing and notifying local parish newsletters of dates and times of meetings. Short reports of the AGM and the fund raising events are also published by the Secretary. 
