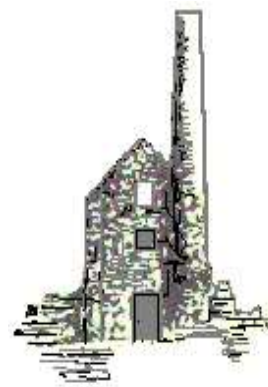

Minutes of St Ive Parish Council Neighbourhood Development Plan Working Group meeting held at Millennium House, Pensilva on Wednesday 30th July 2014 at 7pm.

6. Business

6.1 NDP Questionnaire and Brief for Survey

More NDP questionnaires have been collected from various ballot boxes and have been delivered to Cllr Moss to sequentially number the returns and enter the data into the spreadsheet. An interim version of the spreadsheet should be emailed to group members so we can get an idea of community opinion so far. Cllr Corney to ask Cllr Moss.

6.2 Engagement Plan

We need to mount a stall on Pensilva Carnival Day. Cllr McWilliam will print labels to give to those we ask on Carnival Day. Final details next week.

6.3 NDP Vision and Plan

We will draft policies ourselves and check them with Cornwall Council for planning rigor. The expected structure will be similar to the Parish Plan. From the survey we have 8 different policy areas.

We need to balance the opinions of St Ive (300 residents) with those from Pensilva (2000 residents) so that one community does not impose on the other.

The upgrade of the road from St Ive to Pensilva Industrial Estate is thought to have been part of the original plans – can this be resurrected to support expansion?

For tourism and other policies around the World Heritage Site Area, we need to liaise with both St Cleer and Linkinhorne parish councils.

Cllr McWilliam has resigned from the parish council, but wishes to remain on the NDP Working Group as our Cornwall Councillor.
