Cover Story - Minka - Top Dog of Cornwall

Some of you might recognise our cover-girl, Minka, from her walks around Pensilva, usually with her younger sister Etta alongside and accompanied by Paul and/or Lorna England. Minka and Etta are Belgian Shepherd Dogs, variety Groenendael, one of the four varieties of the breed. (The tongue twister Groenendael is a village just outside Brussels where this variety originated.) They are family pets but in their spare time they are show dogs and they are also learning to compete in Agility, where they jump (similar to equestrian jumps but smaller), walk on see-saws and climb up and down ramps. Minka, whose official Kennel Club name is Champion Chrisvale Loving Feeling with Vanistica, is still only two years of age but has become a champion of her breed and was the top Groenendael in the UK for 2013 and 2014, gaining her Champion title before she was two years old! Recently Paul and Lorna took Minka down to Redruth to compete for the title of Top Dog of Cornwall. There were 28 dogs entered, all having won major awards in 2014. The competition was judged by one of the UK's top judges, Mr Frank Kane, who judges all over the world and has judged Best In Show at Crufts. If you used to watch Crufts on TV (now on the internet) you would recognise him as one of the presenters. Minka won lots of lovely trophies and a massive rosette and is officially Top Dog of Cornwall!

The Parish Council has agreed a budget for the working group to start setting up the new organisations that will be running Millennium House in the future. A charity in charge, and a company to run the bar. By the time you read this we will have selected the initial charity trustees and applied to the charity commission. We intend to reuse the old name of Pensilva Community Association for the charity and Pensilva Community Bar for the company. So that's PC A and PC B.

Pensilva W.I. report

News

From the Chief Constable Shaun Sawyer:

"The latest crime figures, published by the Office of National Statistics for the period up to the end of September 2014 show that crime continues to fall across Devon and Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly. Recorded figures for 2014 showed a decrease of 3.2% (2,747 fewer offences compared to 2013). The updated picture shows the Force continues to see reductions in public order offences (down by 14.8%), theft (-10.7%), burglary (-5.7%), and criminal damage (-5.9%). We have the eleventh lowest crime rate of Forces in England and Wales."

You may also have seen from the coverage on BBC Spotlight in the third week of January that this Police Force has to save £29million over the next four years. This will inevitably mean more cuts in numbers for police officers and police staff, but there have been no decisions made yet as to where precisely those cuts will fall. It is likely that PCSO numbers will be cut but we do not know by how many. Since 2009 this force has already lost 18% of its workforce (13% of police officers and 25% of police staff) and nationally PCSO numbers have fallen by 22%.

In the meantime your local policing remains in place and you have a dedicated and hard working team of officers serving your community.

"My family know what I want, so I needn't bother with a will"

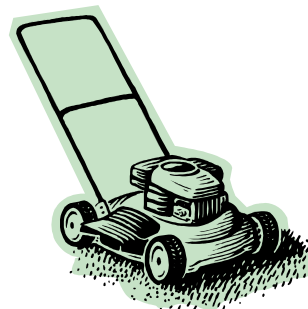

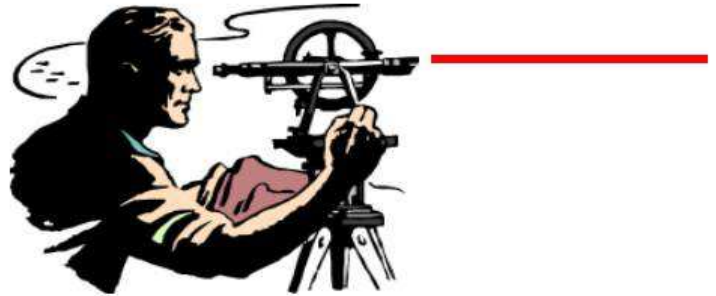
