Then it once again boarded the tractor to continue its circuitous and unorthodox trip to London... via Harrowbarrow!

You will probably have noticed that 100 years ago, when the WI was formed, Britain was at war. Surely it was no coincidence that it was formed at such a dire time in our history. Frances Tucker, president of Pensilva WI, has been doing some research...

"The WI was established to educate rural women and to encourage countrywomen to get involved in growing and preserving food to help to increase the supply of food to the war-torn nation. Education and the sharing of skills have always been at the heart of the organisation and this remains true today."

So, with its roots in agriculture and food production, it's actually rather fitting that the WI baton completed at least some of its journey by tractor! As for all that cake... well, that's also in line with the founding principles, isn't it? From the Parish Pump and its readers – happy birthday and congratulations to the WI, to its 212,000 members, and to the ladies of the Pensilva WI in particular. Keep up the good work!

The Latest from Your Parish Councillor - Martin Corney

Down in St Ive, the Community Park Project has been making good progress in getting new play equipment. We have been so successful in raising funds from different events, that with the community support money from the

solar farm, we have about \pounds 8,000. This together with a grant from the parish recreation ground funds and the landfill tax contributions should multiply up to about £80,000 of equipment. We have met with four different play equipment suppliers, and will shortly be comparing their different designs.

Up in Pensilva there is the proposal for a new estate between Amanda Way and the industrial estate. While this location is not totally unacceptable, it goes against the will of the parish, as expressed in the Neighbourhood Plan survey, for small scale infill development. That piece of land also provides a buffer, between the noise of the industrial estate and the peace and quiet required for residential housing. We need to press on with the Neighbourhood Plan so that it can control future development in the parish. If anyone else would like to help with this plan, please contact me as Chair of the working group.

There is another development of a wind turbine, but this one is just over the parish boundary in Quethiock parish. It will however be not that far away from St Ive church, so is attracting attention from concerned residents.

IT'S OFFICIAL - PENSILVA IS A GOOD SCHOOL

Pensilva School's recent Ofsted inspection confirmed that Pensilva is a good school.

The inspection report praises the behaviour of the pupils, the quality of teaching and the leadership of the school. All the children make good progress because the teachers are effective practitioners and pupils are enthusiastic about their learning.

The report states, "Pupils enjoy learning and are keen to do well in their tasks. They are polite and courteous and say they always feel 'comfortable' at school because everyone is friendly".

Headteacher, Teresa Clinick, said, "We are delighted with the Ofsted report. This is recognition of the commitment and team work of everyone, including staff, governors, parents and, of course, the children themselves."

As the children said to the inspector, "We are part of a team $_{\rm 9}$ because everyone works together to help each other."

Pensilva W.I. report

Tracy Cruiks, South West Health's Safety and Fire Assessment officer in the home, came to the Pensilva W.I. on March 11th. She was very informative and gave a very good talk about safety in the home. She started by saying that a lot of it is common sense and that we all get a bit complacent. Our home is the place of accidents. A lot of women over 65 die because of falls in the home. By the age of 75 both men and women die of an accident in the home or garden. Fires start mostly at night and they start suddenly and spread very quickly. Fire needs three elements to burn, fuel, heat and oxygen. If you can take one of these out the fire will die. Always keep fires well guarded. Keep portable heaters and candles away from furniture and curtains. Make sure the fire is out before you go to bed. Don't dry clothes over the fire or cooker. Minimise smoking especially in bed. Do not leave cooking unattended and smoke detectors should be fitted on each floor of the house. These should be tested regularly. Do not leave rubbish near to the house, they are a magnet for arsonists. Plan your escape route. Get out, stay out and phone the fire brigade. Possessions are not important, your life is. Check electrical appliances for faulty leads or plugs. Do not wire flexes together and have your wiring inspected every five years. Do not overload plugs and extension leads and when you buy electrical equipment make sure it has a CE mark on it. Keep medicines and chemicals in their original containers. All oil paints and spirits should be kept outside. DIY and gardening can cause a lot of accidents. Don't tackle any job that is beyond your capabilities. Do not rush jobs but take your time and follow instructions for chemicals and equipment. Do not work with ladders on your own, have someone to hold it for you and secure it if you are able. Take care of yourself lifting heavy items. Remember that chairs and tables are not to be used for climbing on to change the light bulb! Be safe in everything you do.
