

## **The Latest from Your Parish Councillor, Martin Corney**

At the AGM on 11-May-2015 I was elected to be Chair of the Parish Council for the next year. Alan Moss is the new Vice-Chair. Unfortunately Linda Olver has had to resign from the Parish Council, and we thank her for all her work for the parish.

There are two planning applications that need to be mentioned. The first is a new application in St Ive for change of use of the Butchers Arms public house to a residential dwelling with Bed and Breakfast facilities and a village shop/post office. Although I can see that getting back our shop/post office would be positive, the survey for the Neighbourhood Plan was very strongly in favour of retaining the pub. The second planning application that the architect and housing association involved presented to the Parish Council, is for a new housing estate to be built on the fields between Amanda Way and the industrial estate on the St Ive road. This not only removes the buffer zone between residential accommodation and the noise and smells of the industrial estate, but is not a small-scale development, as required by the Neighbourhood Plan survey. Your opinions of these developments are welcome. Comments on the Butchers Arms change of use can be added to the Cornwall Council planning website (reference PA15/02306). The housing estate already has the pre-application closed (reference PA14/03812/PREAPP) but existing documentation can be viewed.

On Fore Down some unofficial 15 mph signs have been erected, vandalised and removed. I know this is just outside the parish boundary, but if the person who put them up wants the damaged signs back, please contact the parish office.

## **From Cllr Steph McWilliam – June 2015**

Firstly, thank you to those people who took the time to get in touch about how to increase our recycling rates. There were some very good ideas and they will all be fed into the system for consideration. One example of recycling I have only just heard about is that CORMAC are now able to recycle the chippings collected after surface dressing our roads.

Considering the cost of sending anything to landfill these days, this must be a very good investment for council tax payers.

The Cornwall Councillors' community chest is open again with very similar arrangements to last year. I have already had two requests, which I am happy to support, so if you wish to apply, please do so sooner rather than later.

You will know by now the new arrangements for the mobile library service. If you are affected by this, do please let me know how it is working.

I was asked to find out whether Cornwall Council has a policy on Chinese lanterns. We don't but the Fire Service does tend to discourage their use, due to the obvious risk to people, animals and property. However, if you are thinking of using them, there is guidance available on the Cornwall Council website.

It is too early to say what effect the results of the General Election will have on Cornwall Council but be assured, I shall be watching with interest, particularly the funding settlement for local government and what that will mean for services.

I have now nearly caught up with the issues affecting people locally but if you are waiting to hear from me and still haven't by the middle of June, do please get in touch again. It is just possible I have 'lost' one or two notes in the backlog.

*When a call came for volunteers to help to tidy the grounds of the community centre he was there. In short, if volunteers are required for any community activity he will turn up.*

This has been possible thanks to the American writer James Patterson who decided to give money to independent bookshops to help them create projects to encourage children to read. The Book Shop Liskeard was one of the sixty-seven bookshops selected from all over the country.

## PENSILVA VILLAGE HALL

The Village Hall Committee is pleased to announce the purchase of a small section of the car park from Cornwall Council at a nominal sum. This will allow the Committee to progress its plans to remodel the hall with a new entrance from the car park and improved kitchen and toilet facilities. The snooker room will be re-positioned to allow for separate use, and there will be a more accessible space for storage of equipment. After detailed planning has been undertaken the Committee will be seeking grant support to raise the funds necessary.

This purchase has taken over two years to complete and we are very grateful for the support of Councillor Steph McWilliam in getting to this stage. The Village Hall was the original owner of the whole car park in the past and we are pleased that a small section has been returned to us. In the short term there will be no effect on the parking spaces available but as the project develops this will of necessity change.

We have also applied for a grant from the High Down Wind Power Community Fund as part of our ongoing project to replace the hall windows, and we hope to hear about this quite soon.

If you are interested in, or able to contribute towards the Village Hall development in any way, we would be delighted to hear from you.
