

The Latest from Your Parish Councillor - Martin Corney

There has been an interesting development on the planning application in St Ive for change of use of the Butchers Arms public house to a residential dwelling with Bed and Breakfast facilities and a village shop/post office. The

Butchers Arms Preservation Society has been formed, and the pub registered as an Asset of Community Value. At last month's parish council meeting opponents of the change forcefully expressed their views to the new owner. He has withdrawn the application for change of use and offered the community a tenancy agreement. This is an opportunity for the community to run the pub. The offer will only be open until the end of July, so if we want to take up this offer, the time is rapidly running out.

The Community Emergency Plan for St Ive Parish is nearly in place. Unlikely though it may seem now in high summer, it is possible that a snow storm could block our roads, leaving many people stranded and in need of help. There are other possibilities that have to planned for. Mostly we would just be managing the situation until the professional emergency services take over. Copies of the plan and grab bags with vital kit will be stored strategically in Pensilva and St Ive. This plan has been worked on by our Cornwall Councillor's local working group, and under Cornwall Council's guidance for a long time, but is nearly done.

July meeting on Tuesday 28th July

From Cllr Steph McWilliam – July 2015

I am going to have to start with two little grumbles this month. Firstly, at this time of year I am frequently overtaken on the short stretch of road between the cattle grids at the top of Pensilva. I am going slowly because of the lambs, foals and calves who haven't had time to develop any road sense. Almost every time you do it (whoever you are) I arrive in Liskeard right behind you. Please don't wait until you have hit an animal that has appeared without warning before slowing down.

My second grumble is litter at the side of the road. It is bad for the animals and it looks terrible. We are all paying for this mess to be cleared up and there is really no need. Maybe it is because this is a beautiful time of year with all the signs of Spring and Summer but it does seem such a shame that a very few people can't appreciate how lucky we are to live in such a beautiful part of the country and so respect it. Please take your rubbish home with you.

Grumbles over, there is also good news. Cornwall Council is far from perfect and there is plenty of room for improvement but it does do some things very well. Recently it has been recognised for providing very good services in fostering and adoption, working with families with complex needs, bereavement services and dog welfare services. It has also fixed 6,000 potholes and 11,000 other 'carriageway related defects', so it isn't all bad.

The Planning Inspector's interim report on Cornwall's Local Plan is remarkably interesting. It points out the need for more work to align employment space with the strategy for economic development. It also suggests the number of new houses required needs to increase, which will upset some people. However, the increase is likely to be quite small.

Finally for this month, work is almost complete on the St Ive Emergency Plan. Can I please thank all of you who have volunteered to be on the list and available to help if required? We hope never to need you but it is good to know that the community will pull together if required. Once issued, the plan will be available online and in the Parish Office if you would like to have a look. My thanks also to the team who have helped put this together. We have great experience and expertise in this group for which I am very grateful. Thank you all.

Pensilva W.I June Meeting.

Frances Tucker President welcomed everyone to the June meeting of Pensilva W.I. also 2 new members and 2 visitors. After the singing of Jerusalem Jenny Thomas Secretary read the minutes of the last meeting. Jean Hoare gave her report on the Centenary AGM at the Royal Albert Hall London. She reported it was a memorable and lovely occasion which was attended by the Queen, Princess Ann and Sophie Countess of Wessex, who are all members of the W.I. The main subject on the agenda was the resolution which called on the government to remove the distinction between nursing care and social care in the assessment of the needs of the individuals, in order to advance health and well being. After a lot of discussion it was decided not to vote on this resolution as it was poorly framed and was such a complicated subject a lot more research was needed, although all agreed that urgent changes needed to be made. Next Verna Dawe gave her report. She had attended the W.I Royal Garden Party which was hosted by the Duchess of Cornwall, The Countess Wessex and Princess Alexandra. Verna looked very smart in the outfit she wore on the day, and made us all very envious with her descriptions of the royal gardens and also of the lovely tea that had been provided. She stated it had been an unforgettable experience.

Our speaker for the evening was Diane Stevenson who gave us a wonderful tour in pictures of Mount Edgumbe House and Cotehele. She had worked at Mount Edgcumbe for 20 years giving tours of the gardens and house and had done a lot of research. She told us of the history of the families who had lived there and of the lives of the people who worked for them. Lots of questions followed and she was warmly thanked by Yvonne Gilbert.

HELLO AGAIN A long illness over the winter prevented me writing for some time, so I'm delighted to be feeling well enough to do so again. VOLUNTEERING AND GROWING LOCAL PRODUCE Our fabulous volunteers have done a great job of keeping our crops healthy and happy over the time I was poorly and everything is about to burst forth into seasonal plenty once again. In recent weeks, we have harvested salad leaves, beetroot, shallots, onions, garlic, peas and broad beans. These were replaced with tomatoes, climbing beans, chillies, peppers and sweetcorn. New potatoes, strawberries and courgettes are just ready and looking fantastic.

It's so satisfying being part of the whole process: from crop planning to planting, harvesting then taking the veg boxes to our customers. We are always keen to welcome new volunteers and there's certainly plenty to do. We meet every Weds 10 a.m.— 2pm, have a great time together and get fit too. Home-made soup and bread provided for lunch.

VEG BOX SCHEME We are so pleased with the lovely vegetables grown for us by Laura at Tregillis Organic Farm, South Petherwin. She brings weekly deliveries of salad leaves, lettuce, spinach and whatever else she has ready. The quality and freshness is unbeatable and a great back-up to what we contribute to the boxes. We are also now getting some superb produce from Di at Chapel Bank Organic Farm, Warleggan. She will soon have a bumper crop of strawberries, if there are jam-makers reading.

To enjoy fabulous fresh local fruit and veg, delivered to your door, order your veg box now. Box Prices are: £7.50 for 1 /2 people, £10 for 3/4 people, £15 family box and the very popular £5 fruit bag.

COMMUNITY COMPOST SCHEME We welcome your lawn clippings, used rabbit bedding, cuttings, etc at our compost bins by the gate. Please make sure none of it has been sprayed with weed-killer. If you use weed-killer on your lawn, please dispose of your clippings through the Council scheme, as it could damage our crops. Your contributions help to create much needed compost for our community garden.
