

The Latest from Your Parish Councillor - Martin Cornev David Waddington has been welcomed back onto the Parish Council after many years of absence. His previous experience as a Parish Councillor makes him an invaluable addition to our ranks. We still have vacancies on the Parish Council, so if you

contact the Parish Clerk. Leesa who is also a new addition to the team. The Butchers Arms Preservation Society has decided to turn down the new owner's offer of a tenancy agreement to run the pub, since the terms were not considered to be workable. The pub is still registered as an Asset of Community Value, and the Butchers Arms Preservation Society would consider purchase if it comes on the market.

The resurfacing of Higher Road Pensilva has reinstated the speed restriction cushions. Many people asked for these traffic calming measures to be left out of the replaced surface, but Cornwall Council told our Cornwall Councillor that it would actually be more expensive to change the paperwork, than to put the bumps back. It does occur to me that this might be a blessing in disguise. Before the bumps were added, the traffic on Higher Road used to rocket through the village, endangering life and limb. There was a clamour to do something about speeding traffic and so the speed cushions were added. Maybe they are a good thing. What do you think?

## From Cllr Steph McWilliam – August 2015

Well, Cornwall Council voted in favour of the Deal for Cornwall, giving us more powers in areas such as bus franchising, integrating health and social care, employment and skills and the spending of EU funding. It sounds good but I voted against for a few reasons, not least that the whole process was very rushed and not debated in public. Because of this we were given the documentation in the Council Chamber and given 20 minutes to read it. It was 20 pages long and I got to page 11 before the debate began. I didn't feel there was sufficient time to consider all the implications and so voted against. It may be excellent and all good for us but I just don't know. As the paperwork was taken from us as we left the chamber, I still haven't managed to read it all. Another reason for me to vote against was that housing and planning, two of my top three elements, were not included. Finally, the transfer of any tax raising powers (keeping a proportion of VAT, fuel duty, stamp duty etc) are off the agenda, at least for now.

There has been some essential maintenance done on the planning website. If you have an alert set up, it might be worth checking if it is still working because mine appears to have stopped since the work and needs to be reset. I am having some difficulty finding my way around the system, which is always the case with changes, but hopefully it will be worth it once we become familiar with the new layout.

There has been a fair amount of coverage in the local media about the evaluation report on the EU convergence fund. It makes disappointing reading but hopefully lessons have been learnt and we will see more highly paid jobs and more economic growth from the projects in the current spending programme.

I didn't realise until recently but there is a Handyperson scheme run by Cornwall Council for over 60s and disabled people. This is for small jobs and/or where you don't want strangers in your home and aren't sure how to check someone's credentials. If you think this might be useful for you, ring 01872 224707. Thank you.

# REPORT ON THE PUBLIC MEETING HELD ON JUNE 26 2015 ON THE FUTURE OF MILLENNIUM HOUSE

At this meeting the new charity, Pensilva Community Association CIO, presented to the community of Pensilva (and beyond), and in particular to the groups that use Millennium House, what is going to be happening with regard to the running of Millennium House (MH) in the future.

The content of the presentation was roughly the same as the content of the leaflet that should be included with your Parish Pump this month. So I won't go into detail on that. Since I was the one doing most of the presenting it would clearly be wrong of me to say that the presentation was very well received, so I'll just say that a neutral would probably have remarked on how positively the presentation was received:-) The biggest round of applause of the evening was for Karen Lawrence who talked about the work of the Events Group. Even better for me was the bit when my 5 colleagues at the front each spoke about what it is that motivates them to press on with the work we're doing. I was moved.

Afterwards people had the opportunity to sign various registers offering help when the time comes. Several of us adjourned to the bar and there was a real buzz in there. It was gratifying to feel that others shared the vision of a vibrant and successful community centre that we have been clinging on to for the last 12 months.

A few days later I bumped into our Cornwall Councillor, Steph McWilliam, who had attended the meeting. I hope she won't mind my repeating her comment that she had never felt so positive about the future of MH as she did after that meeting.

About two weeks after the public meeting there was a Parish Council meeting at which the PCA constitution and business plan were due to be discussed. Unfortunately there was a procedural issue and the discussion had to be postponed to an Extraordinary General Meeting on Monday 20th July. In a way that was a good thing because by then we had finalised the heads of agreement that lay out how the Parish Council lease of MH to PCA will look, and also the contract dealing with the handover of the business of MH to PCA. These documents were also up for approval by the Parish Council at the EGM. All matters were approved, meaning that the way is now clear for PCA to take over the management of MH, probably on October 1st. On the legal side we now await only recognition of PCA by the Charities Commission and signature of the lease and handover agreement once the solicitors have done their work.

Your business helps us to keep working together to grow healthy vegetables and healthy people.

NEEDED We have decided to convert our entire outside growing operations to raised beds. At the moment the land is constantly trying to revert back to a field and we struggle to stay on top of weeding, strimming, etc. So we will need a lot of tannalised timber and would be very grateful to collect/receive old decking, or anything that we can upcycle into raised beds.

VOLUNTEERING AND GROWING LOCAL PRODUCE Our fabulous volunteers work hard every Wednesday and the results are showing. We are harvesting tomatoes, climbing beans, new potatoes, courgettes, basil, blackcurrants and raspberries; we hope the runner beans and peas are going to catch up with themselves soon after an uncertain and cold start to the growing season.

It's satisfying being part of the whole process from crop planning to planting, harvesting and then taking the veg boxes to our customers. We are always keen to welcome new volunteers; there's certainly plenty to do.

We meet every Weds 10 am - 2pm, have a great time together and get fit too. Home-made soup and bread provided for lunch.

VEG BOX SCHEME To enjoy fabulous fresh local fruit and veg, delivered to your door, order your veg box now. Box Prices are: £7.50 for 1 /2 people, £10 for 3/4 people, £15 family box and the very popular £5 fruit bag.

COMMUNITY COMPOST SCHEME We welcome your lawn clippings, used rabbit bedding, cuttings, etc at our compost bins by the gate. Please make sure none of it has been sprayed with weed-killer. If you use weed-killer on your lawn, please dispose of your clippings through the Council scheme, as it could damage our crops.
