The Latest from Your Parish Councillor - Martin Corney

I am please to say that our Neighbourhood Development Plan is moving forward with two new members joining the committee. This committee has not met for a long time. Last year the NDP committee presented our work at public meetings, both in Pensilva and St Ive. At these meetings we asked you to tell us what you

thought the important issues were for the future planning of our parish. This guided us as to what questions to ask in the questionnaire that everyone was asked to complete last year. The results of the questionnaire have been analysed and the report is available on the parish website. This now needs to be turned into planning policies in a plan that we can vote on in a referendum. Planning decisions for the parish will then have to be based on what we have democratically decided locally, instead of just being whatever Cornwall Council choose.

Transferring the management of Millennium House from the Parish Council to Pensilva Community Association is taking a lot longer than expected. The trouble with having volunteers running the Parish Council is that we only have our spare time to get work done. This is also a new undertaking that we want and need to get right, but is a steep learning curve. We are however making progress.

From Cllr Steph McWilliam – October 2015

At a recent meeting at County Hall, all the Group Leaders were committed to Cornwall Council's efforts to help with the refugee crisis. However, we are also aware that we have a severe housing shortage and a funding shortfall for existing services. Officers are working with other councils, the LGA (Local Government Association), the government and various charities to ensure we do what we can without unintended consequences. The offers from the people of Cornwall to take refugees into their homes are much appreciated but the welfare of these vulnerable people must be the priority. It may be, for example, that Cornwall is not the best location for unaccompanied children, who may need specialist support and contact with those who speak their language. Whatever the outcome, please be aware that there is a lot going on behind the scenes.

Apparently councillors have no role in planning enforcement, which came as a surprise to me. I am often asked to look into activity which may be outside of the planning permissions granted and where enforcement action is being taken. I had assumed that if the local community asked me to intervene I could request that the decision be made by a committee or for the decision to be reviewed but it seems not. However, do please continue to notify me if you have concerns and I will continue to ask questions about whether this system needs a few changes.

We now have a date set for a 'desk top exercise' to see how well our emergency plan will stand up to scrutiny. This is for the team developing the plan but if you have any thoughts on what sort of emergency might befall the parish, please let me know before 8th October. You can also volunteer to be on the list of people we can contact for help, should the need arise. Please let Jane Mann know on 362960 or Rev Kev on 363336.

Finally, I have just had confirmation that the winter maintenance plan for our roads will be the same as for last year. This may not be all we would like but at least it hasn't been cut back any further.

Thank you for your support and for keeping me up to date with your views on local matters.

DOG FOULING

The Parish Pump has received an email from a resident of Penharget Close in Pensilva. The children who live on the Close have built themselves a den at the entrance to the cul de sac, where they like to play in the afternoons. An inconsiderate and irresponsible dog walker (not a resident of the Close) is allowing their dog to defecate in the den, causing distress to the children and concern to the parents. By any civilised standard this behaviour is completely unacceptable and we can only hope that the person concerned puts a stop to this behaviour immediately.

Dog owners are required by law to clean up after their pets. E.g. Cornwall Council's website states:

Failing to clean up after your dog has fouled will result in a fixed penalty being issued - which is for £80 (reduced to £50 if paid within 10 days) or prosecution where if found guilty you would face a maximum fine of £1000. (<https://www.cornwall.gov.uk/environment-and-planning/animal-welfare/dog-welfare-and-enforcement-service/dog-fouling/>)

PENSILVA HISTORY GROUP REPORT - SEPTEMBER 2015

On Saturday 12th September the History Group arranged a guided walk around the Phoenix United Mine complex. The walk was attended by 25 people and was led by John Manley, local author and Chairman of the East Cornwall Branch of The Trevithick Society. John's latest book "William West – The Last Great Cornish Engineer" tells the story of this celebrated engineer and his dealings with the Phoenix Mine. William was the Chief Engineer of the mine and owned enough shares to give him a controlling interest. The walk began in the Minions Heritage car park then down the track to the remains of the Prince of Wales Engine House where we stopped to view the remains of the buildings while John recounted the history of the mine and the technicalities of the various machines that would have been operating there. We continued past these old workings and onto the vast cleared area beyond that would have contained engine houses, stamping machinery, various whims, buddles and ponds to store water for the steam engines. John then led the group through the woods and down into the valley to view many mine remains including the stone built housing for a vast water wheel. The wheel itself must have been huge and the troughs to carry the water to it must have towered above the trees.

The walk ended at the old mine Count House, which is now a private residence, where William had often addressed the miners and staff from the balcony. The History Group hope to arrange another walk around the old mine engine houses led by John next year.
