

Some of you may be wondering what on Earth is happening with the new charity, Pensilva Community Association, and its plans to take over the management of Millennium House from the Parish Council. The situation at the moment is that there are two issues that are holding things up. Firstly we are waiting for the Parish Council's lawyers (Cornwall Council legal department) to deliver the legal documents covering the lease on the building and the commercial terms for the handover of the MH business. Secondly, the Parish Council is still awaiting a definitive opinion on whether it is legally entitled to go through with the deal. With so many proposed start dates having been and gone I have given up trying to predict when the handover may happen. It's all very frustrating, especially as the losses at MH continue to rack up.

I am writing this in the depths of midwinter and I'm struggling to remember a Christmas where the general mood has been so dominated by bad weather, bad news and tragic events. Having said that, the MH Events Group continues to try to lift our spirits by organising loads of events. I really enjoyed the Polperro Fisherman's choir on December 12th. The Events group does great work and deserves our thanks.

From Cllr Steph McWilliam – January 2016

Happy New Year to you all. I do hope you had a good time over the festive season.

Our new CEO, Kate Kennally, is starting on 11th January and I look forward to working with her. We are still working out the implications of the spending review details but relieved that we can raise council tax by 2% for adult social care spending as this was a huge worry. At least we should be able to continue protecting the most vulnerable, even though we don't expect other services to improve significantly as far as funding is concerned.

From time to time we have problems with temporary traffic lights failing out of hours. Apparently there is always a number to ring on a board by the lights so if you know of this happening, please try and find this number first. Ringing CORMAC takes longer because different organisations have reasons to set up temporary traffic lights and there are various firms that do this. They are all 'approved' but will have different contact details. Please ring the number direct if you can, otherwise the lights will be causing problems whilst CORMAC works out where they are and sends somebody out to find the contact number to get them fixed.

There are still problems with dog attacks on sheep. Owners will often say "They are only playing" but this is no excuse. Dogs must be kept under control at all times and must not be allowed to chase the animals on the moor. They must also not be allowed to chase or 'worry' people either!

I am pleased to say that there is growing support for a 40mph speed limit across the moor. We will collate all the comments we receive to help the Commons Council make its case strongly and convincingly.

Free dog micro chipping is still ongoing. Do please get your pets identified this way. If you have a rescue dog that is already chipped and need help getting the contact details changed to yours, just let me know and I will put you in touch with someone who can help you do that.

The emergency plan is now more or less complete and has gone to the relevant officers for 'sign off'. There will be a copy held at St Ive Village Hall and one at Millennium House once it has been approved and adopted. Thank you so much to everyone who has helped produce it and to those who have volunteered their services if we do ever need it. I sincerely hope we never do and that it will never be used.

I really do appreciate the support you have given me this year and that so many of you have taken the trouble to get in touch and let me know your thoughts and suggestions. Please don't stop and I will continue doing the best I can to represent this community and make your voices heard.

The Latest from Your Parish Councillor - Martin Corney
Happy New Year everyone. I'm writing this just before
Christmas, which has already been a real boost for me. I'm in a
position where I can voluntarily give my time to a number of
community organisations even more rewarding than the parish
council. This year the food bank where I volunteer organised
Christmas boxes as a little extra, given by members of the

community to those who needed to use the food bank through the year. Delivering those surprise boxes of Christmas goodies was the most rewarding thing I've done this year. People's reactions varied from the stunned to the very emotional. Everyone was grateful for the unexpected gifts that could make their Christmas special, and I was grateful for the opportunity to make a difference. There are lots of different volunteering opportunities locally depending on ability. I might choose to help with scrub clearance on nature reserves or DIY at The Growing Project Pensilva; others help in reception at Millennium House. Anyway I highly recommend volunteering as something to start doing, maybe as a New Year's resolution.

The parish council is about to set the precept portion of our council tax. We have two options: Delegating the management of Millennium House to the Pensilva Community Association charity (PCA), or carrying on as usual. If we carry on as before the precept will have to go up dramatically, from £62,000 probably to about £87,000. If PCA take over, the precept could actually reduce slightly. This is because parish reserves would not need to be as large for a smaller parish turnover, and as a charity PCA can save money.

THREE GOLD MEDALS FOR NIKKI WELCH, FROM PENSILVA, AT THE 4 NATIONS PARA-BADMINTON CHAMPIONSHIPS IN IRELAND

Following a gold medal win at the Bournemouth regional singles badminton competition in October, Nikki Welch from Pensilva took part in the Irish 4 Nations Para-Badminton Championships over the weekend of 21st November and returned home proudly displaying THREE GOLD MEDALS. On the Saturday Nikki won all 6 singles and 6 mixed and women's doubles games. On the Sunday Nikki faced three finals and some very experienced players, but she remained calm and focused to beat the local Irish Special Olympian Clare O'Neill to win GOLD in the singles and then in the doubles, with her new partner Linzi, to beat Clare O'Neill and Sarah-Louise Rea. In the Mixed Doubles Nikki and new partner Lloyd Crawley beat champion Michael McCraw from Lothian Scotland and his partner for the event Jackie Robins. Nikki thanked Tournament Director and Ulster Badminton President William Martin for organising and running a faultless event which helped her stay relaxed and focused to win all THREE GOLD MEDALS.

Claire Reed from Liskeard Junior & Inclusive Badminton Club, where Nikki trains, said. 'We are very proud to have Nikki as part of our Club and are delighted at her achievement. Nikki is dedicated to her Badminton and her results reflect that. Her family deserve huge recognition for ensuring Nikki is able to attend these competitions. We will support Nikki as much as possible to achieve her dreams'.

The club has been awarded Premier Club status and is still celebrating after winning Junior Club of the Year at last month's Cornwall Sports Awards 2015. They have also been nominated by their National Governing Body, Badminton England, for the National Badminton Awards 2016 to be announced in March. It is the Hub Club for East Cornwall Community Badminton Network and a member of Special Olympics Cornwall. They have sessions at Lux Park Leisure Centre on a Monday including 'No Strings' pay and play sessions. They also have two satellite clubs at Launceston and Bodmin.

Nikki has several tournaments approaching, but her long term goal is the National Special Olympics which will be in Sheffield in August 2017.
