From Cllr Steph McWilliam – February 2016

Well, the big issue of the moment is the budget. The Chancellor's settlement is complicated and it has taken our officers some time to analyse and prepare a briefing for us to explain the implications.

Probably the biggest question will be whether we should add 2% on top of the likely 1.97% increase to help with the shortfall in adult social care services. Adult social care is my biggest concern and it is some relief that we could increase council tax above the referendum threshold to help but this still won't be enough. We have an increasingly elderly population and it is proving harder and harder to recruit people to this area of work. I am quite sure that none of us wants to be cared for by people who don't want to be doing the job so we do need to value those who are.

We are having problems with emergency services vehicles not being able to get through when they need to due to inconsiderate parking. We know it is getting harder and harder because there are more vehicles per household. Many of our homes were built before the days of any cars, never mind three or four per family. By the time we add in garages used for everything except cars, caravans, motor homes and boats on driveways and often works vehicles and vans, it is starting to look like an obstacle course in some roads in the evenings. Please bear this in mind! It could be your home that the fire engine or ambulance can't reach. If you are mobile enough to park just a few yards from your home, please be thankful for that and do so.

There isn't really any more to report on the Devolution Deal or the boundary review at the moment but I'm sure both these issues will feature in the next couple of months.

The parish council raised concerns about the request to lift the condition on some empty affordable homes in Fore Street. I agree that the time it is taking for these houses on new developments to be occupied does seem to suggest we now have an over-supply or the wrong types of affordable homes are being built. I am working with the parish council to try and work out what is going wrong and see how we can correct it. If you are on the housing register (Homechoice) and have been unsuccessful in finding a home in the parish, please let me know why. Is it that the empty houses are too expensive, in the wrong place or too large, for example? Thank you.

The Latest from Your Parish Councillor - Martin Corney Well, most of you will probably have heard that the Parish Council has decided to put up the precept from £62,000 to £64,770. This wasn't what I wanted, but only two of us voted against it. I said that a whole hearted commitment to passing control of the loss making Millennium House community centre over to PCA (Pensilva Community Association) would

allow us to reduce the precept to £60,000, while continuing as normal meant that we would need to increase the precept to £80,000. This was based on the budget produced by the RFO (Responsible Finance Officer). The Parish Council have chosen to follow the budget produced by the Finance and Administration Committee for running Millennium House the same as before. I hope that the next financial year works out OK. It seems that we now have to make the PCA plan work if the parish is not to eat dangerously into the reserves.

I'm very glad that the issue of bus stops and bus shelters in St Ive village has been raised. Although Pensilva had several new bus shelters added by Cornwall Council last year, St Ive only has one old shelter at Keason. The places where the bus stops through St Ive need clarifying and rationalising. It isn't safe for buses going West to stop opposite the Keason bus shelter, the stop in St Ive Parkfield is possibly not official, and the stop at the Butchers Arms may not be actually in the lay-by with the phone box.

The Butchers Arms Preservation Society have been in touch about the decision by Cornwall Council to declare a very strange part of the Butchers Arms site as an Asset of Community Value. They have divided the whole site into four and declared that only the building and part of the car park count. This apparently perverse decision is being questioned with Cornwall Council.

Pensilva WI January Report

At the meeting on 13th. January, Tony and Pat Hill talked about how they came to built an Eco house. Tony received redundancy from his work and they decided to move to the West Country and build their own house. Not just an ordinary house but an Eco house. They found an old tin house in the woods outside the village and started the process. The house would be south facing to get the benefit of the sun. There were various planning procedures to go through before they could do anything to the old house in eight acres of woodland. Finally all the hurdles were overcome with the planning process and heavy machinery was brought in to pull down the old house which was largely made of tin. Whilst Pat talked about what was happening, Tony showed a video of what was happening. The sight of the old house being dismantled gave us an insight of what was going to happen before their house was built. Tony had made a model of their dream house. As they had plenty of woodland the obvious choice was to use wood to make the framework of the house. The wood after being cut had to be left for two years before they could use it. A lot of the old house was also used to make their house. Local labour was the builders and friends, family and neighbours. First a concrete base was laid on a membrane and the wooden walls built. Cedar wood was used for the roof and the walls laid like roof tiles. Finally the interior was started with wooden floors and wood everywhere. The cavity wooden walls were filled with sheep's wool to keep the heat in. They have a wood burner to heat the house and a system of heat recovery that heats the fresh air coming in the house so that the house has warmth as well as fresh air. They used recycled billiard tables for the kitchen work tops. The house has three bedrooms, kitchen, study, large lounge with a balcony overlooking the woods, utility room, study and bathrooms. The balcony is as high as the tops of the trees so they feel part of the wood. They grow their own vegetables and fruit, if the deer don't get there first! They won an award from The Royal Society of Architects for their unusual design. A very interesting talk from Tony and Pat.

Lottery Funding will help the Growing Project to grow!

The Growing Project in Pensilva is proud to announce that is has recently been awarded a grant of £9,000 by the BIG Lottery small grants scheme Awards for All.

The new *Grow More Project* will convert their outside growing area to raised beds, renovate the vegetable box packing space and create improved volunteer facilities.

Work on the project will start on Wednesday this week when a local timber company WH Bond delivers the first consignment of timber for raised beds. It is planned that these will be built over the winter, ready for planting out in the spring.

Project Co-ordinator, Ruth Wilson said:

We are so pleased to have been awarded this grant. It will help us to greatly increase our production of fruit and vegetables, make the community garden more accessible, deliver more veg boxes to local homes and support more volunteers to get involved in growing local food. There's nothing quite like harvesting baskets of the tomatoes, courgettes and peas that you planted earlier in the year, knowing local families will be taking delivery of them that day fresh as can be.

An Open Day in the early summer will welcome community members to see the new facilities and encourage volunteering.



That was not the only fundraising event in January as we also held a quiz on the 23rd which raised over £50. This capped a very successful spell of fundraising over the festive season. 


