From Cllr Steph McWilliam - April 2016

There is a lot of emphasis on safeguarding at the moment so can I please ask everyone to think about this. It covers child neglect, abuse, domestic violence, trafficking and other forms of control. I don't know of anyone being abused, trafficked or being held as a modern day slave in this parish but I am not naïve enough to think it isn't happening somewhere near here. It almost certainly is. It is a difficult situation if you suspect something but aren't sure if you should mention it and that is where I can perhaps be the most help. Having attended several briefings and training sessions, I am confident that Cornwall Council has a good system in place to deal with reports like this and would be comfortable being the one to bring it to the attention of the relevant team. If you don't want to report it yourself, tell me (362037) and I will pass it on without naming you. If you are comfortable passing it on yourself, ring 0300 123 1116. Obviously in an emergency you should use 999. Remember – If you see something, say something.

Party politics doesn't usually feature at all in my council work or in these articles so I have thought long and hard about saying this and decided to ask you for your views. The EU referendum will be held on 23rd June and is a very important vote, whichever side of the debate you are on. If you have already made up your mind, that is fine but if you are confused by all the arguments being put forward and are undecided, I would like to hear from you. If there is any interest in me setting up a question and answer session, I am happy to do so but will need time to find someone to put the case for staying in, since I am obviously in favour of us leaving. I represent all of you and have no intention of using my position to promote my case without giving equal representation to the opposite view but I would like to know if this would be helpful. If so, please let me know on 362037.

I would like to say a huge thank you to all those who do such a great job picking up litter in their spare time and for no reward. If you would like to volunteer to help, do let me know. I would also like to hear from you with suggestions about how we stop people dropping so much litter along the verges in the first place. It is such a shame and is, as always, a small minority who spoil our beautiful countryside for everyone.

In particular, can I make a plea to people not to drop their poo bags at the side of the footpath between Glen Park and Jubilee Road? One of our public-spirited neighbours has requested a bin be placed there but, wherever you are, please don't just leave it for someone else to deal with.

To finish on a more positive note, the sun is shining and hopefully spring is on its way. We do live in a beautiful place with low crime rates, many good people who help others and plenty to be thankful for. Let's keep it that way.

The Latest from Your Parish Councillor - Martin Corney

I often get asked about what's happening with the Butchers Arms pub. Well, having met with the owner, members of BAPS (Butchers Arms Preservation Society), and our Cornwall Councillor, it seems that the Butchers Arms still has a future as a pub. The building is boarded up and so looks

abandoned, but having seen inside, it is in a good dry condition. All the furniture, pumps and kitchen have been cleared out, but the bars, flagstones and pub signs are all still there. A lot of work needs to be done to get the pub running, but the owner will invest if someone can be found to lease the pub. BAPS are investigating options, or maybe a new landlord will step forward.

Three quarters of the Pensilva Recreation Ground East field owned by Cornwall Council and used by different parts of the community such as; the Primary School, the junior football club and others is being disposed of by Cornwall Council. Pensilva Recreation Ground charity owns the West field with the main football pitch, and a quarter of the East field. Cornwall Council are inclined to transfer the land to the Primary School in preference to the Parish Council and are not considering the Pensilva Recreation Ground charity. This seems like a bad move for the community, since both the Parish Council and the Primary School are likely to try to build on the land when short of cash. In order to preserve the land for community use it should be transferred to the charity which is obliged to keep it for recreational use in perpetuity.

It's been suggested that we should walk the Parish Paths. Does anyone want to join me inspecting our paths, especially if you know them well, as I don't know them as well as I'd like to.

Pensilva WI March Report

At the meeting on 9th March Pat Ward talked to us about the rebuilding of Boconnoc, the ancient and unique house near Lostwithiel. It is believed that the house has been there since the Civil War, when it is thought that thousands of troops and their horses were stationed there. It once belonged to Thomas Pitt and family and has been visited by Charles 1st and 2nd. In the Second World War troops and ammunition were housed there, after which it fell into disrepair. Then for thirty years the house lay idle and gradually became a shell. Walls and ceilings fell and the house was like that until the Fortescue family took it on. Although there was no money to rebuild they gradually started the renovation. Various events were held to raise the money and gradually the house and gardens were restored as we see it today. It has been restored to a very high standard and the pictures that were shown were beautiful. We saw wonderful pictures of the interior of the house and the garden in all its seasons. The church which is next to the house was also restored and many artefacts were found that suggest that it has been there since the Doomsday period. We were shown slides of the house and the gardens and they are very grand. Many shows and activities are held there and the money helps to preserve it. In 2012 they received a Restoration award.




Pensilva Memory Café

We will also throw in tea and biscuits as well as sparkling conversation.






