Neighbourhood Development Plan Event The Future of St Ive Village

St Ive Village Hall, Friday 27th May, 5pm to 8pm

The Neighbourhood Development Plan Working Group will be presenting new ideas and hearing your feedback, for development in St Ive along the A390.

The parish has a development dilemma. Pensilva has lots of development, but poor access. St Ive has little development but being on the A390 excellent access. Should St Ive be the part of the parish for more future development? Does St Ive need more development in order to thrive as a community?

The Butchers Arms has been closed for a while, but could be reopened with a nearby shop. Would this be a viable concern without other development in the area? The field opposite has planning permission for industrial units. Would this provide enough extra business? The old rectory where Emily Hobhouse was born may be opened as a museum about her. The church has been in difficulties with a reducing congregation. Does the village need new families to invigorate it? Should St Ive stay as a collection of scattered housing with few facilities, or develop with job opportunities and housing for young families? Would St Ive benefit from mains sewerage and mains gas as part of development? If development happens, where should it be sited? All these issues will be presented for you to consider and give your feedback. Please come along at any time between 5pm and 8pm on Friday 27th May to participate.

Letter received from Craig Vaughnley, chairman of the Pensilva School Governors, in response to comments by Martin Corney in the April Parish Pump concerning the Pensilva Recreation Ground Field.

In last month's edition the parish councillor for St Ive claimed that if the land were to be transferred to the school it might be possible that the school would sell the land to raise money.

The first inaccurate comment was that the land was to be transferred to the school. This is incorrect and the land is being transferred from Cornwall Council to CCET, the Caradon Cooperative Educational Trust. The land is an important asset to the Trust. We requested the transfer to prevent the sale as the land could have stayed in Cornwall Council control.

The school has never owned the land which has always been owned by Cornwall Council. The school only has responsibility for its upkeep and maintenance.

Martin's comments were not based on fact unfortunately and if this concern had been raised with myself I could have easily clarified the points raised in Martin's section of the Parish Pump.

I apologise on behalf of the school if Martin's comments have raised concerns over the running of the school. The land is simply being transferred into trust.

From Cllr Steph McWilliam - May 2016

Spring is definitely on the way but with our typical Cornish climate, we seem to be managing two or three seasons in a day at the moment. Even so, the warmer sunny days when the wind drops are really welcome, as are the longer daylight hours. Whatever the weather, I am still always grateful to live in and represent this part of Cornwall.

The community chest is open again. I am delighted to say that all the money was used last year for activities within this division and I hope we can do the same again this year. Please don't hesitate to contact me if you are seeking funding for local community projects.

Initial responses to my question about setting up a 'question and answer' event about the EU referendum suggested there wouldn't be much interest. However, I have now had more replies and there does seem to be support for the idea so I will see if I can find someone to join me who is already committed to voting to remain. Any suggestions for somebody who is clearly impartial to chair it will be much appreciated, as will your thoughts on when and where to hold it. I don't think it will be worth holding sessions in each parish so, at the moment, I am considering Millennium House which is quite central, perhaps on a Sunday afternoon.

Although work is underway on the electoral review (Boundary Commission), the Devolution Deal and a Governance Review, there are no decisions or outcomes to report yet but I will keep you posted when there are.

I drove around the three parishes after the last storm and would like to use this column to thank all you heroes who do your bit to look after yourselves, your neighbours and your neighbourhood. I know I didn't see all of you to thank you personally but it is appreciated. I know we still have some real problems to sort out – and we will – but we would have a lot more if it wasn't for our civic minded residents who just quietly get on with things like clearing drains and waterways.

The Latest from Your Parish Councillor - Martin Corney

Pensilva is within two miles of the Bodmin Moor Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and so will be included in the buffer zone of the newly proposed Bodmin Dark Sky Park. The Parish Council supports this proposal as will strengthen planning regulations for a better environment and improved

year round tourism. Bodmin Moor has crystal clear skies because of the prevailing winds coming over the Atlantic washing out most atmospheric dust. Cornwall Council have been putting together a bid with the technical support of Caradon Observatory at Upton Cross. The bid for Dark Sky Park status is currently at the consultation stage and will be ready to be submitted this Autumn. More details and links to the Cornwall Council information are available on the parish website. The Parish Emergency Plan will be presented at the annual parish meeting 7.30pm 25th May. This is a plan that has been created by members of the community together with the guidance of Cornwall Council.

I've been asked to remind people that they must pick up waste from their dogs when walking them. This is a very emotional issue for many people, and now that it is mandatory for all dogs to be chipped, there is a demand from many to take the DNA profile of dogs when they are chipped so that each dog can be traced from anything they leave behind. I've also noticed that large carrier bags are being left next to the specialist dog waste bins. This is totally unnecessary since the dog waste disposal rules have changed to allow inclusion in household waste. We used to have to buy special dog waste bags from the council, to be collected on special days; this is no longer the case.

The woods are again treating us to the glorious green tones of Spring and the ever-increasing evidence of the wildlife that have made it their home. On a sad note, many of you will have heard or seen that the carved sign at the entrance to the community woodland was vandalised beyond repair in early April. Upsetting as it is to feel that there are people in the village who can do that to a community resource and a charity set up for the people of the village, these things happen and we move on. Our next task is to set our minds to raising the funds to replace it. (We have a quote for about £450!).

More now than ever, we need your support. You can of course make a donation to the charity or put in an order for firewood for next winter, the funds from which go back to the charity. We also need people who use the site to join the committee to help us look after the woods and encourage community involvement. No experience necessary and no need to get involved in the physical management of the woods unless you feel able. It's more about showing support than anything else. We are having our AGM on Monday 23rd May, meeting at the main gate to the woods at 7pm then wandering through the woods and down to our home for tea and cake. EARLY PLANTINGS Our team of weekly volunteers and our HelpX volunteers, Erin, Alex and Lorenzo have worked their socks off over the last 2 months. We have filled all of the raised beds with green waste compost and manure and planted most of them with their first crops. Coming up now are carrots, cabbage, kale, turnips, parsnips, peas, broad beans, onions, leeks, onions, shallots, garlic, salads and potatoes. We still have space for French and runner beans and courgettes, squashes and sweetcorn. Fingers crossed that the weather is with us, after such a dreadful season last year.

FURTHER WORKS Because Bond Timber gave us a hefty community discount on our timber order, we are able to afford 6 more new wooden raised beds and Trevor Webb has agreed to help us clear the land for those very soon. After that, we will renovate the veg packing area so that Lily has a safe and comfortable space in which to pack our veg boxes. We will also create a warm dry volunteer rest room for those days when it's too cold to eat lunch in the field. We have also been donated the materials to build some cold frames, so that we can thoroughly harden off seedlings before planting them out.

VOLUNTEER SESSIONS In recent weeks we've sometimes had over 10 people working on site and that has allowed us to do make big improvements, clearing grass, brambles and organising things in a much better way. The tunnels look fantastic, the craic is great and we are building a solid team, as well as having fun and staying healthy. If you'd like to join us, we're here from 10-2 every Weds.

OUR VEG BOXES enjoy fabulous fresh local fruit and veg, delivered to your door, order your mixed veg box now. Prices are: £7.50 for 1 /2 people, £10 for 3/4 people, £15 family box and the very popular £5 fruit bag. Or drop by our veg stall which is refreshed with all sorts of seasonal delights every Thurs. Please put your cash in the post-box on the gate.

COMMUNITY COMPOST SCHEME We welcome your lawn clippings, used rabbit bedding, cuttings, etc at our compost bins by the gate. If you use weed-killer on your lawn, please dispose of your clippings through the Council scheme.

Pensilva WI March Report

Tony Wood came to our meeting on 13th April to talk to us about how Liskeard came to be the town it is today. There is a well in Liskeard, that has been there for a number of years and has never run dry. The first time that Liskeard has been mentioned was in the Doomsday Book in 1086. Liskeard was a village and the main occupation was agriculture. In 1240, Richard Earl of Cornwall granted certain rights, such as markets and fairs and the town became a thriving market town. Eventually copper was found in the Caradon mines on Bodmin Moor and the population in the town grew. Many fine houses were built to cope with the rising population, and there were a great deal of slum buildings too. St Martins church, the second biggest church in Cornwall was built on a former site of a Norman church. The granting of markets and fairs helped the town to grow and prosper, and the finding of copper was another good factor for the town, but the Copper dwindled and so did the population. Tourists are now what the town relies on. Henry Rice, a great architect, built many fine buildings in the town which still look good many years later. Mr. Wood showed us slides of the town which show the town as it was growing and as it is today.



We will also throw in tea and biscuits as well as sparkling conversation.






