There followed discussions on Millennium House and then on dog pooh, (or was that the same discussion?) Anyway, it seemed like the right note on which to end.

From Cllr Steph McWilliam – June 2016

The work on the electoral and governance reviews continues and is important but doesn't yet have any specific decisions. At this stage it is more of a technical exercise, collecting stats and figures to be used in the final outcome. However, do keep an eye out for opportunities to comment, probably in late summer.

I am not aware of any specific problems with care packages for any of the residents in my division but if you do know of any, please let me know. I voted for the increase in the budget to assist with pressures on these services so I do want to check that it was the right decision.

The Independent Remuneration Panel's report is now available online and it does recommend an increase in councillor's allowances. By the time you read this, we will have voted on it and it looks likely that the recommendations will be accepted. Before you get too cross about it, please bear in mind that it only applies after the next election (so you have a chance to vote us all out and try a different lot of councillors) and that it is intended to help more people stand for election. I really think it would be good if Cornwall Council had more younger members but with the current allowance, it is likely to carry on being mainly retired people with a reasonable pension. I would encourage you to try and read the report. It explains the reasoning behind the increase much better than I can.

I am still on a mission to try and reduce the amount of litter spoiling our beautiful countryside and hope to be able to work on a project with our school children. They are likely to be more persuasive than me. My thanks also to the resident who called me about the recycling lorries leaving the flaps open when they left the village so that rubbish was flying out the back as they picked up speed. Apparently it was quite common and hopefully all the operatives have now been reminded of the need to secure the flaps.

Finally, I was delighted to be able to attend the ceremony at County Hall where a civic award was given to Dennis and Doreen Cardew. The fantastic response to this being posted on facebook was further evidence of how highly they are thought of and how lucky we are to have people like this in our community.

Thank you to everyone who contributes to the very best of our rural community.



At the Parish Council Annual General Meeting in May, I presented my Chairman's Report and was re-elected by my fellow councillors for a second year - thank you. Since the vast majority of us do not attend these meetings, I'll summarise my report here.

Over the last year we have lost four councillors by resignation and gained four by co-option and one by

election. This high turnover is regrettable, but understandable given the stress of dealing with all the issues that occur. Don't forget that all of us are volunteers on the Parish Council, giving our time to keep your community running.

The big problems over the last year have been to do with money. Parish Council reserves fell by another £9,000 continuing the trend of recent years. This brings our reserves to dangerously low levels, and we need the reserves to finance projects. Thanks to the community in St Ive we installed the fantastic new play equipment. This needed community involvement and fund raising, funding from the solar farm, and landfill funding from Viridor Credits. But we also needed our reserves to pay for the equipment up front before claiming the grant money. So you see that the Parish Council finances are key to future projects. We also need reserves for unexpected bills like the one for £18,000 from Cornwall Council for the 50% business rates discount that they decided to retrospectively to take away from us.

To save money in the future we need to lease Millennium House to Pensilva Community Association. This is a project that has been worked on for two years and is nearly finalised. This has taken a lot longer than planned, but when the users of Millennium House are running it as a community centre, without the financial support of the Parish Council everyone benefits, and the precept can be reduced.

The car park behind Millennium House is in a very bad condition. We are trying to raise funds to relay the car park, but as ever this is a slow process. There has been a bad accident when someone fell over so please be very careful.

PENSILVA WI MAY REPORT

The Horticultural Show will be on Saturday 10th September. The schedules are ready in Millennium House. Let's make this year's show another great show!

At the meeting on 11th May, Chris Boughton talked to us about beekeeping. He had a little trouble with the film that he wanted to show us, but all was well and we had an interesting evening. Chris is a member, and has been for many years, of various beekeeping societies. We need bees to forage for pollen and nectar to keep our agriculture and flowers thriving and of course to supply us with honey. The Queen bee takes half the swarm and makes another swarm. Many of these swarms are in unusual places. There was a film of one being made in a blown down tree and when the man was sawing up this tree, there was this swarm. I bet he ran fast! They can be on chimneys so Chris has to climb for these. There was one in a post box that caused a bit of a stir. Once the swarm are established they forage for the nectar and pollen from a vast array of flowers. Dandelions are a favourite flower. They also like ivy, so keep a bit growing. It was an illuminating talk and the bee is a very hard working creature and we should protect them as much as possible.

Francis told us of the sad death of Jean Lewis who was a member for many years.

The litter picker-uppers did a grand job and picked up bags of litter, five from the Millennium field. Don't forget Jean's party for the Queens birthday on 12th June. Tombola prizes, food and a fancy hat.

There was a recent County meeting that is held twice a year and Jean and Kath went and they sounded as if they had a good time by the report that Jean read out.

Several ladies went to a party for Ivy Gardener, a past member who reached her 100th birthday. A good time was had by all.

The grandson of one our members is going to do a sports day to attempt to get a Gold Duke of Edinburgh award so some of our members are going for it. Watch this space.

The Flower of the month was won by Jill Pascoe, 2nd was Jean Hoare and 3rd was Mary Gilbert.

The competition of a honey pot was won by Cherry Woodhouse, 2nd was, Mary Gilbert and 3rd was Mavis Phelp.

At the next meeting on 8th June we shall listen to Roger and Viv Bennet singing and playing on Guitar and Flute some Cornish songs and tunes.

Pensilva Primary School

This is an exciting time to be a pupil at Pensilva School. There are so many different projects that are under way including a 'We Will Rock You' performance. Our drama group, which includes year 3, 4, 5 and 6 children, have been rehearsing for months now to be ready for their performance at Sterts on Thursday 9th June 2016 at 1:30pm. This is open to the public, tickets are £5 for adults and £3 for children and are on sale at Sterts. This promises to be high-energy entertainment.

To continue the drama theme, Key Stage 2 children are also involved in the Tinth Project with other schools from the Caradon Cooperative Educational Trust. This comprises of artwork, writing, music and drama revolving around Cornwall and culminating in a two days sharing of works and joint drama at Sterts. On the second day, there will be two performances, a matinée at 2:40pm and evening at 6pm, free to parents of the children performing.

Meanwhile, both in and out of the classroom, we have been fortunate enough to have Landmark Travel working with Warleggan Class. This incorporated a workshop where the children wrote legends, made puppets and performed their legends at Dupath Well.

As part of a national experiment one of our classes is growing seeds, some of which have been to space, to see the effect of space travel on growth.

We are fortunate to have a school council which actively helps us to be a healthy school, raising money for charity, buying much needed equipment for the playground and giving the children a voice in the school, including in setting some curriculum content, which clubs they would like and what they would like to do with the school grounds.

We are trying to rejuvenate our outside area and plant up our pots and raised beds. If anyone has any extra plants they have grown from seed, or seeds & bulbs they no longer want, please bring them along to the school and we will give them a good home. If you need them collected then call the school and someone will pick them up. Thank you!

Finally, we have our own forest school, which runs weekly and gives the children an opportunity to experience nature first hand. The key aim of this innovative learning is to inspire individuals and improve their studying across the curriculum.

We will also throw in tea and biscuits as well as sparkling conversation.


