COVER STORY - Double Cornish Marathon!

Oli Jones, a PE teacher at Pensilva primary school, completed the Cornish marathon twice in one day running 52.4 miles on Sunday the 20th November. Starting the first marathon at 4:30am in the wake of storm Angus, he and his running friend Mark had to contend with strong winds and flooded roads near the Draynes valley. After completing the course once, they then joined around 450 other competitors for the official Cornwall Marathon, which starts and ends at Pensilva's Millennium House. Oli and Mark took a total of 9 hours and 32 minutes to complete the two laps, raising money for Cancer charities. Children from the school were involved serving refreshments to runners along the course and even running the end of the first marathon with Oli.

Children in the school have been taking on their own "52" challenge by doing 52 sets of an exercise or activity, such as 52 minutes cycling or 52 bounces on a trampoline.

Field between Belmont Park and Goodmans Lane

Further to my request in the October Pump, I am sure all the walkers would like to thank Tony for selflessly giving up 1 hour of his time to cut a path through the field with his hedge-cutter and tractor. I know this is a temporary measure as it will probably be overgrown again next year. I have spoken with Cllr Steph McWilliam about the problem and she is looking into the ownership and future maintenance of this footpath and entrance.

Now that the field has been made accessible again there are horse riders using this path. It is getting churned up and we have to walk through horse manure. I would like to point out that this is a footpath, not a bridleway. S Malone

From CIIr Steph McWilliam - December 2016

I am always very proud to represent the Lynher Division but never more so than at the Royal British Legion Remembrance events. Once again I was able to attend services and lay wreaths at Upton Cross, Golberdon and St Ive. All three were beautifully arranged and all enhanced by contributions from our young people. I'd particularly like to thank the Yr 6 children at Upton Cross for being so respectful and involved, Marcus Coleridge for playing the Last Post at Golberdon and Jake Hibbin, the ATC standard bearer at St Ive. I managed to speak to all of them and can confidently say that our community is in safe hands for the future with young people like this growing up here. The weather is still being very kind to us and this does mean there are more people out and about on the moors. Please enjoy our lovely countryside but be aware that some of the animals have started looking for food and are becoming rather too bold as a result. This has resulted in one person having her arm broken by a pony, despite being somebody very familiar with horses. The message, once again, is please don't feed the animals on the moor. I can assure everyone that the extra 2% on council tax last year was spent on adult social care as promised and it is quite likely that the same will happen next year. You may have heard of a residential care home in St Austell being closed due to concerns about the standard of care. I am not able to share details but I am confident in saying that the council acted swiftly and decisively to deal with this matter immediately it came to light. I don't agree with everything this council does but am happy to support the decision to protect our elderly and vulnerable as our top priority, and we do. We are still working on how the council might function with fewer councillors in the future. I understand the temptation to just say 'get rid of the lot' but I think we might be like housework: if we're doing a good job, you shouldn't really notice; if we're not, it is possible things could get worse! There is some discussion that we don't need as many and can change our role to focus more on the strategic issues. This would mean spending more time in Truro at council meetings and less time working in our communities. Because we don't have district councils, we are under-represented if you work out how many electors per councillor we have. The counter argument is that we can work differently, don't need to attend parish council meetings and can just direct residents to council services rather than getting involved ourselves. If you have any thoughts, please let me know. Finally, I would like to wish you all a very Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year. 2016 has been an interesting year and also an extremely short one. I can't believe my next article will be for 2017 but hope we can all look forward to a peaceful and prosperous time.

As I write this the Parish Council have just received proper legal advice on the correct procedure for leasing Millennium House to any organisation such as Pensilva Community Association. By the time you read this the Parish Council will have held an EGM to discuss this legal advice and decide the way forward for Millennium House which is still being

funded as a community centre by more than half of the Parish Council precept (the Parish Council part of our council tax). The Parish Council is also in the process of setting next year's precept.

If there is a demand for it, I am thinking of providing free guidance in the community centre to people who would like to use a computer for basic things like sending emails and searching for information on the internet but don't know how. My elderly father has just worked out how to order his regular NHS prescription using the internet, which saves him a trip to his GP practice. I imagine that many in the parish could benefit from this service. If you would like to take advantage of this offer, please contact me and I will make arrangements in the new year.

Newsletter - December 2016

This month we have some wonderful news and some very sad news. Let's start with the good news. We have been awarded a grant by the Big Lottery Fund which will finance an upper-body trainer and the replacement of most of our elderly cardio-vascular equipment. The upper body trainer (which is a like an exercise bike where you turn the pedals with your hands and arms) will greatly increase our provision for wheelchair users and other members with mobility problems. All Being Well's philosophy (reflected in the name) is that everybody deserves the chance to experience the benefits of exercise, and having this new piece of equipment will help us to fulfil that mission even more effectively.

The CV equipment we are replacing has been in service since we opened in 2000 and it was second-hand even then! It has lasted extremely well but is starting to fail, so the opportunity to replace it has come at the perfect moment. Specifically we are replacing two cross-trainers, two rowers and a treadmill (the other treadmill having been replaced last year). That leaves us with just the bikes to replace (and we have applied for other grants for those!)

We are very grateful to the National Lottery for the funding; the new equipment was sorely needed and it allows us to look to the future with confidence. It is due to be installed on December 1st, so by the time you read this it will be in use!

That brings us to the sad news. After seventeen years as our manager and chief instructor Mel Weldon will be leaving us at the end of the year. The demands on Mel's time have become unmanageable and she feels that she cannot continue to give ABW the time that it needs. (Continued on next page)

Under Mel's leadership the gym has been branded with her unique personality, her values and her priorities. Those of us who have worked with her have been awed by her unfailing enthusiasm, friendliness and dedication. 




