## St Ive Parish Council

## Minutes of a Meeting of the St Ive Parish Council Parks and Open Spaces Committee held at 11am on the 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2018 at Millennium House.

- 1. Those Present: Cllrs Carr, Corney, P Haimes, Libby and Vaughan (Chair). Also Peter Dipper.
- 2. Apologies: None, all present.
- 3. Councillors Declarations of Interests: None.
- 4. To Receive the Minutes of the last meeting: Agreed as an accurate record Proposed by Cllr P Haimes, Seconded Cllr Libby Unanimous.
- 5. Matters arising therefrom:

To receive updated information

- A. Weed Killer: There was a discussion about glyphosate being in all commercial weedkillers and Cornwall Council not spraying around schools. It was proposed by Cllr P Haimes seconded by Peter Dipper that roadside pavements in Pensilva be sprayed, except around the school. Agreed by 5 votes to 1.
- B. Road Salt Prices: Cllr Vaughan reported that Cornwall Council's website says they will fill salt bins free, but only once. Cormac require payment. Both statement could be true. The Parish Clerk is pursuing this with Cornwall Council. Cllr Vaughan suggested that we need to buy sacks of salt to store, but the cemetery shed needs to be cleared first.
- C. Football Club Paint Offer: Cllr Vaughan reported, No reply received.
- D. Skate Board Park: Cllr Vaughan reported, No action.
- E. Right of Way, Goodmans Lane to Belmont Park: Cllr Vaughan reported, No action.
- E. Street Sweeping Schedule: Cllr Vaughan reported that Cormac are to sweep the roads of Pensilva.

- F. Playdale Equipment Check: Cllr Vaughan reported, Nothing heard yet.
- 6. Plan to sort Cemetery Shed: Cllr P Haimes proposed and Cllr Carr seconded that we buy materials to fix the shed to the value of about £127. Unanimously agreed. Cllr Corney proposed and Cllr P Haimes seconded that we scrap the metal chairs stored in the shed. Unanimously agreed.
- 7. Winter Planning: Cllr Vaughan suggested that we buy salt bins; one for Church Hill and two for the newly tarmacked Millennium House car park. It was thought one bin might be sufficient for the car park footways. Cllr P Haimes proposed and Cllr Carr seconded that we buy two salt bins.
- 8. Tree Surgery: Cllr Carr reported that the Millennium House neighbours bordering the West boundary hedge have all agreed to it being cut. The hedge needs to be reduced in height. Cllr P Haimes reminded that the cemetery trees need a qualified and insured tree surgeon to climb and trim trees piece by piece. Peter Dipper knows a contractor he has used. Cllr Corney reminded that all work should be delayed until birds had finished nesting.
