St Ive Parish Council - Chairman's Column

First of all I would like to say a big thankyou to Karen and all of the Carnival Committee for another successful Carnival week, ending with an excellent Carnival day. I hope all the groups that put effort into organising events made money for their groups.

As I go round the Parish I notice several pavements with hedges growing out over them, making access difficult, I would remind landowners and house owners that they are responsible to keep their hedges trimmed, in bad cases Cornwall Highways may trim the hedge and bill the owner,

During July we had an instance of people camping on Pensilva Recreation Ground (not local people) but I would like to remind everyone that no **camping or dogs** are allowed on Pensilva or St Ive recreation grounds.

Some people may have heard of a dispute between the Parish Council and the Football Club. It is all over the fence around the pitch on the recreation ground. The Parish Council and the trustees of the recreation ground have voted to hold the football club to the original verbal agreement to have a temporary and not a permanent fence around the pitch. Prior to carnival week the Parish Council removed some of the permanent fence posts (the Charity Commission say that permanent fences are not allowed). The rope barrier can still be put up for matches but must be removed after, and to this end councillors have offered to put up the fence for evening matches, when time is tight before a match. All the advertising hoardings can stay along the top of the field, with some portable signs being placed by the goals if required. These actions form part of a contract between the council and the club, which will formalise the agreement, and we await their response.

Finally with summer holidays upon us if you are using the recreation grounds please use the litter bins or take your litter home.

OUR VEG STALL We are able to fill up the stall with fresh produce from the garden on a daily basis now, so it's always worth a look for bargains. Please put your cash in the post-box on the gate.

COMMUNITY COMPOST SCHEME We welcome your lawn clippings, used rabbit bedding, cuttings, etc at our compost bins by the gate. If you use weed-killer on your lawn, please dispose of your clippings through the Council scheme.

Nikki Welch has just returned from Wrexham, North Wales, with two gold medals. She won the badminton regional games, ladies singles and mixed doubles events, class 1, quite convincingly. TAMAR VALLEY HEALTH PATIENTS' GROUP NEEDS AN INJECTION!

In the last few months, for a variety of personal and health reasons, your Patients' Group has lost several key members of its Committee. In fact, the Committee has virtually ceased to exist and useful projects have had to be dropped for lack of support. You will all be aware of the pressure that GP services are under across the country and it is becoming very difficult to maintain the high standard of care that we have become used to and expect. In addition, major changes are being planned for how primary health and social care services will be provided in Cornwall in the future. It is very important therefore that patients have an effective way of expressing their views on these issues and can contribute to their solution.

Here are some of the key things that Practice Patient Groups do:

- Collect feedback from patients on their experience of the care provided both by survey and by direct contact.
- Make suggestions for changes and improvements to the services provided.
- Advise and comment on changes and developments planned by the Practice.
- Support the Practice by helping to publicise important issues that affect their patients.
- Sponsor and publicise campaigns for healthier living.
- Monitor official NHS and other surveys comparing the Practice with others. Overall, you could say that the Patients' Group acts as a "Critical Friend" of the Practice.

Could you spare some time to help the Practice keep up and if possible improve its current standards of service? Volunteers are needed for roles such as officers or members of the Committee and people able to offer occasional help with individual projects.

You may have seen posters for Memory Cafes and wondered what they are about. They are a great place for people with dementia and memory problems to socialise in an informal and friendly atmosphere. Memory Cafes are held in Liskeard, Callington, Launceston, Downderry, Looe, and many more places in the South West. Most are held monthly, some are more frequent.

Pensilva has its own Memory Cafe. It is a small friendly group who meet once a month for tea and cake and a bit of relaxing fun. We might have some music, a simple game or quiz, and a bit of reminiscing. You can join in if you want to, but nothing is compulsory. 


