



#### A message from the Revd Becca Bell

Hello!

My name is Becca Bell and I am the Parish Priest here in Pensilva. I have been here for 9 months now and time has flown by. My first article for the pump is to share the good news that the members of St John's Church have taken the decision to leave its doors open during the week, for people to drop in and make use of the quiet space.

St John's Church is a church of friendly and kind people who work hard to maintain the building. However, it has long been felt that it is a waste for it only to be open for a few hours each week. It will be open from 10.00am to 4.00pm from the 1st September.

We need to ask for some help from you, the community. Would you be willing to pop in from time to time so that it is never long left empty? One of the risks that is posed in leaving it open is that there are those who may make mischief in there. If the community could take a moment to pop in and sit for a minute or two in the peace and quiet, then it would ensure that we could keep the building open in the long term, for the sake of those who may need to take time in the church.

Leaving the church open also means that visitors will have access to the loo!! (Please leave as you find it!)

We will keep you posted as to how this experiment goes.

#### Parish Council Chairman's Column

I must start this month's column on a serious subject: in the middle of August a 3 year old boy was riding his bike in Pensilva recreation ground in the vicinity of the skate park with his grandfather when he fell off. Unfortunately he landed on a broken bottle and cut his hand very badly. His injury required 4 hours of surgery. Thankfully it appears he should make a full recovery, but it could easily have turned out very differently. I would ask all parents to impress on their children the dangers of broken glass and not to break any bottles they may find, just put them in the bin. Sadly two days after this incident 4 more broken bottles were found in the children's playpark. If anyone finds any broken glass please make it safe and report it to the staff in Millennium House as soon as possible please. A change of subject now, car parking in the vicinity of St Ive Village Hall. This is a very narrow road and if people park in the road to attend functions at the hall they restrict the ability of residents to access their property and for large vehicles to use the road. I would ask all users of the Village Hall to please use the car park provided at the recreation ground. As the evenings start to draw in I would like to remind all cyclists to have working lights on their bikes. Parents also, if your children are out in the dark please check that they have working lights on their bikes and ensure they know the importance of using them.

A quick advert for the coffee shop at Millennium House, it is now being run by volunteers for a trial period and it's open on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday mornings. Why not pop in for a cuppa and a chat, or even volunteer to help run it? **Use it or loose it.**

Are you caring for someone with Dementia, or do you perhaps have concerns about your own memory? It can be lonely and worrying but you're not on your own. Many people around you are in the same boat. You don't have to feel isolated. More people than ever are becoming dementia aware, and most organisations need, and want, to be dementia friendly.

You may have seen posters for Memory Cafes and wondered what they are about. They are a great place for people with dementia and memory problems to socialise in an informal and friendly atmosphere. Memory Cafes are held in Liskeard, Callington, Launceston, Downderry, Looe, and many more places in the South West. Most are held monthly, some are more frequent.

Pensilva has its own Memory Cafe. It is a small friendly group who meet once a month for tea and cake and a bit of relaxing fun. We might have some music, a simple game or quiz, and a bit of reminiscing. You can join in if you want to, but nothing is compulsory.
