St Ive Parish Council Climate Emergency

Report of Follow-up meeting held on 12th April 2019

Having passed the motion declaring a Climate Emergency on 11th March 2019, the parish council called this public meeting to air the issues and outline ideas and plans for reducing carbon use in the parish. Cllr Martin Corney presented slides outlining the problem and what actions the parish council can take to reduce carbon emissions.

The parish council has restarted the Neighbourhood Development Plan (NDP) process by appointing parish councillors to form the core of a working group. Creating the NDP is a slow process: it will take at least a couple of years. It is necessary to form the enforceable legal foundation for our planning policies, but it is not sufficient, especially for quick action, so there will also be a Climate Action Group. There will be a lot of overlap between the two groups, so they will need to keep in close contact, but there will also be many areas in the NDP that address wider concerns than carbon use. Also the action group will look at many issues that do not belong in the NDP.

The Climate Action Group will be looking at lots of issues around the parish; Housing, Transport, Energy, Food, Education and Land Use, to name but a few. One urgent issue was whether the Millennium House gas boilers, which are on their last legs and need replacing, should be replaced with heat pumps. Another issue was about community energy; should we form our own local cooperative to produce our own renewable energy?

Both the NDP Working Group and the Climate Action Group will be holding regular public meetings and the community needs to get involved.

And, while we are talking about environmental issues, the Parish Pump has received the following message from a parishioner:

The first visit of the season was an enjoyable and informative daffodil walk at Cotehele, led by National Trust gardener Vicky Dillon. There were beautiful drifts of daffodils in the pasture opposite the restaurant, in the meadow and in the old orchard. Vicky explained that they were mostly older varieties donated by the market gardeners of the Tamer Valley and gave club members the chance to learn the names and classifications of a number of the many varieties grown at Cotehele, albeit just a fraction of the 30,000 odd varieties overall.

From the Practice Manager at Pensilva Health Centre / Oaktree.

In order to improve the experience and level of care that we offer our patients, Oak Tree Surgery and Pensilva Health Centre will be **changing our clinical computer system**. Our advised date for this changeover is 21st May 2019 and we have a dedicated team of personnel working tirelessly to ensure this process is as efficient as possible.

What will this mean for you?

Routine appointments: Routine appointments will be reduced during the changeover and we let you know the dates as soon as we can.

Urgent appointments/advice: Please be reassured that access to advice and appointments for an urgent medical need will continue to be available on a daily basis throughout the changeover period.

Online Services: Access to online services via The Waiting Room will cease and we will be using a new system called Patient Access. If you are already registered for online services, we will contact you shortly with further instructions. If you are not currently registered for online services, and would like to sign up in order to be able to order your repeat prescriptions, make appointments or view your medical records online, you will be able to contact your practice to set this up once we have the new computer system in place.

Prescriptions: After the 10th April two months of medication will be provided for any prescription request received. This is to ensure that there will be no delay in you receiving your medication during the changeover period.

We will be happy to answer any queries that you may have.

Thank you for your on-going patience and co-operation during this period.
