2	Apologies for absence were received from Cllrs. I Vaughan, T Hodson, J Bruce and Mrs J Hoskin (Parish Clerk).	
3	Councillors Declarations of Interest. To receive and grant any requests for dispensations. None declared at this stage of the meeting.

Mr Trevasgis gave an update on the installation of the electric car and charging points stating that the equipment had been ordered and the two charging points should be installed in the next few weeks.
