6	Matters Arising / matters outstanding not included on this agenda. There were no matters arising.	
7	Update on the problems encountered in Shute Lane, Pensilva.  P Dipper notified the meeting that he had spoken with an officer (Rebecca Dickson) of Cormac about the flooding in Shute Lane and he was awaiting a callback from one of her colleagues. Owing to the recent resurfacing of Quarry Lane it was evident that there was no natural drainage to take the surface water away. The path was not maintainable as a highway but was maintainable as a public right of way.	PD
8	Update on rectification of issues in Piggy Lane. It was suggested the path should be closed until Cornwall Housing had carried out repairs to the wall adjacent to No. 6 Highfield Estate. The fallen stones posed a trip hazard to those using the path. A site meeting will be requested. Cllr N Libby reported that overgrown branches from the Old Parsonage also needed to be trimmed back. A letter had been sent but the property had been sold and occupiers had now changed. A further letter will be issued to this address.	Clerk

	To consider discussing with the school a joint maintenance plan for the field hedge. The trees required trimming and part of the hedge had been broken down by those using this routs as entry in and out of the field from Slade Park Road. The school had previously asked for an all-weather track around the field, and a wild flower meadow had also been proposed.
