	Cllr Willis welcomed everyone, introduced himself as the newly appointed parish council Chairman and explained the process for this meeting.	
2	Apologies were received from Cllrs T Hodson and I Vaughan.	
3	Declarations of Interest. To receive and grant Councillors requests for dispensations. None.	
4	Report on the activities of the Parish Council from Cllr A Moss. Cllr Moss gave a report on the activities of the parish council and the current financial status. The new community vehicle was expected to arrive within the next few week's and this was also available for community groups. The funding and application from the solar farm were explained. The meeting was notified of the May 2025 parish and town council elections.	
5	Report from the Neighbourhood development Plan working group. Cllr Steer outlined the work of the NDP and identified the group members, explaining what had been done so far, and work for the future; along with the partnership working with Plan Support and Go Collaborate. Public consultation events had been held in April and the process had now started for the residents to complete questionnaires that were available online or by paper copies at Millennium House. The design guide was available for viewing. A referendum would be held sometime in 2025. The website was available with all information plan4stive	
	Cllr Seeva outlined the hard work and time taken to produce an NDP and his role with the CC Strategic Planning Committee.	
6	Questions from members of the public / any other reports for this meeting. • Pensilva Women's Institute - Mrs Alison Willis gave an excellent presentation on the history of the W.I and the organisation locally. The group had celebrated their 75 th birthday in 2023. The wide-ranging activities were portrayed and anyone was encouraged to join.	

Tregovenek – Ellie and Hayley gave a talk on Tregovenek, a place of hope within the community resilience project that had been formed on 8 acres of land on the parish boundary. A space that provided health and wellbeing for the local community. A place to learn, connect and work together taking into account aspects of regenerative agriculture. There were currently 24 members with 30 active volunteers, holding 500 meetings, 9 courses and 40 events. Cllr Phil Seeva – Cllr Seeva introduced himself as the neighbouring Cornwall Councillor that had now been asked to take on the work of Cllr Daw who was on long term absence. He will work with the Leader of the Council, Cllr Linda Taylor to ensure the needs of the parish are addressed at county level. The Community Chest money was available to fund smaller projects within the ward area. 7 To close the meeting. There being no further business the meeting closed at 8.15pm.
