2	Apologies for absence were received from Cllr. N Gisby.	
3	Councillors Declarations of Interest. To receive and grant Councillors requests for dispensations. None declared at this stage of the meeting.

The Chairman invited the members of the public to address the council if they so wished. O A parish councillor from St Cleer introduced himself and gave a report on his aim to install defibrillators in local industrial estates. Two had already been installed at Doublebois and the gentleman was asking for funding to support a four-year maintenance package for a new defibrillator being installed at Pensilva Industrial Estate. The cost being £200 per year. Money had been sourced for purchasing the machines. To date the defibs had been provided by SW Ambulance but may change in the future. It was proposed by Cllr Moss, seconded by Cllr Mann and unanimously agreed that £800 be taken from the solar fund to cover the maintenance of the Pensilva Ind Estate defibrillator for four years. The Clerk suggested the Cornwall Councillors Community Chest Fund may also have some funding available. O A member of the public had attended to observe the meeting.

Cllr Corney reported the trees at Tokenbury Cemetery were being surveyed Neighbourhood Development Plan Working Group. Cllr Steer reported on the public events held at Pensilva and St Ive on the 26th /27th April 2024 that were well supported. Cllr Farley congratulated the group on these events. Another event was being planned for the 20th July with a representative from the Cornwall Council Historic Environment Office. Questionnaires were now available online and in paper format. Help was needed to deliver flyers to homes throughout the parish. 	
12	St Ive Village Hall – update on plans for building a new village hall at St Ive. Cllr Farley circulated information to Councillors including the report of the public meeting held on the 18 July 2022. The surveyors report on the existing hall to be circulated to Councillors. Cllr Corney reminded the meeting that the Trustees had approved the concept of the project to build a new hall on part of the recreation field land. He had contacted the Charity Commission who asked for clarification on some matters. The hall committee required permission from the trustees of the field stating they would lease a section of land for this purpose, should this be permitted. The constitution for the charity may need to be changed. Cllr Farley will contact the CC planning department seeking preapplication advice. It was proposed by Cllr Vaughnley, seconded by Cllr Libby and agreed by the majority that in principle a hall could be built on recreation field land if legally allowed.	RF
