A regular visitor from St   Ive was pleased the Parish Pump magazine was once again being produced. He asked how the council were getting on with reviewing the parish paths. He was asking for historic paths, currently not defined, to be added to the public rights of way network. Evidence applications needed to be submitted by 2032. 11	Parish Council vacancies and co-option. Two vacancies on the Pensilva ward.  P Steer was unable to re-stand for election in May 2025 owing to her connection with the Cornwall Council electoral staff. It was unanimoulsy agreed she be co-opted onto the Pensilva Ward. Proposed by Cllr Corney, seconded by Cllr Carr. Cllr Steer signed her declaration of acceptance of office.  The council also agreed to co-opt Freddie Southcott that had applied for a Pensilva ward vacancy, and invite him to attend the next meeting. Proposed by Cllr Corney, seconded by Cllr Libby and unanimoulsy agreed. (the decision was made in the closed session of this meeting – agenda item 18).	
12	Matters to be reported and noted by the Clerk / Items for the next agenda. None.	
13	Local bus service and public concerns. Inconsistencies with the local bus services in particular the No. 74 Callington – St Ive – Pensilva – Liskeard not arriving and the gap in the route for the No. 11 Plymouth – Dobwalls – Padstow were noted.  The routes provided by Go Cornwall, part of Plymouth City Bus.	
18\) 14	A report on the uptake for the Local Transport Scheme. Cllr Carr reported the success of the community car with 33 bookings so far this month. More volunteer drivers were always needed. Cllr Moss notified of the meetings with the external valuator that would continue until three years after the lottery funding was given. The third started in October 2025. Customer and driver surveys were being produced.	AM
15	Electric vehicle charging point for public use. A question on this subject was raised at the Annual Parish Meeting but the spare charging point at Millennium House was not currently available for public use. The current facility worked on a fob system and this would require adapting to a payment machine. This was not currently feasible, but a commercial company may be able to look at options in the future.	
16	Overgrown hedges between Fore Street and Jubilee Corner, and Shute Lane. Sites were identified although it was difficult to locate some landowners. Councillors noted the bird nesting season when hedges could not be trimmed.	
17	Date of next Full Council Meeting – Monday, 14 July 2025.  To consider holding a parish council meeting at St Ive Village Hall.  Following a vote of four in favour and four against the Chairmans casting vote supported the decision to hold two meeting at St Ive during the summer months. Cllr Corney to confirm if wi-fi is available in the hall.	МС
